A Message from Archbishop of America Demetrios

Encyclical of Archbishop Demetrios for the Feast of St. Basil and the New Year – January 1, 2013

Feast of Saint Basil and New Year

Be renewed in the spirit of your minds, and put on the new nature, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness. (Ephesians 4:23)

Beloved Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we come to the beginning of a new calendar year, we are very familiar with the atmosphere of expectations and hopes for new beginnings that pervades our modern world. With the changing of a number and the turning of a calendar page, many people seek to leave behind experiences and challenges of the past year and look forward to a new year and the possibility of new opportunities and better circumstances in life. Others are thankful for the events and memories of the year that has passed, and greet the new year with anticipation of greater things to come.

While we are influenced by this element of our culture which is linked to how we mark the passage of time, we know as Orthodox Christians that there is a much more appropriate focus in reflection on the past and anticipation of future—the grace of God. It is His grace that offers us forgiveness and hope. It is by His great mercy that our hearts, minds and bodies are renewed. Through His abundant love, we are filled with gratitude for all that He has offered, and we look forward to a new year of tremendous blessings.

This focus on the newness of life we find in God’s grace is essential each day of our lives; but, it is also very appropriate on a day when we commemorate Saint Basil the Great. This is an affirmation of the power of grace. In venerating the life and witness of Saint Basil, we recognize that God’s grace was “poured out” upon him, so that he not only had the power to “reveal divine things” but also, to be a “minister of the Gospel.”

In his writings, sermons, and letters, Saint Basil emphasized the vital role of God’s grace

as it has been revealed both in creation and human life, and through the ongoing work of the Holy Spirit. He also illustrated the power of grace through a life dedicated to caring for the sick, the orphaned, and the elderly.

It is also on this day and throughout the month of January that we recognize the sacred work of Saint Basil Academy. Each year we are led by our National Philoptochos Society and local chapters in collecting funds for this ministry of grace. As you participate in the special offerings and the cutting of the Vasilipeta, I ask you to give generously. The care, healing and love offered by the board, directors and staff at Saint Basil Academy is a faithful witness of the power of grace. Each day, the children and youth at the Academy see and experience the love of God and are offered examples of the necessity of communion with Him. In this atmosphere filled with grace, they are able to find the guidance, peace, and joy that they need in their young lives.

In addition to your gifts for Saints Basil Academy, I ask you to remember this ministry in your prayers. May you also prayerfully consider the power of God’s grace in your life. As you begin the new year, be ready for the great blessings that God will offer to you and through you to other people. In your commemorations of this day, may you be assured that God’s love and mercy are with you always. On this day of renewal, I pray that you and your families have a happy and blessed New Year.

ΚΟΙΝΩΝΙΑ

Μήνυμα Αρχιεπισκόπου Αμερικής Δημητρίου

Εορτή Αγίου Βασιλείου και Νέου Έτους

 ημών και ενδύσασθε τον καινόν άνθρωπον
 τον κατά Θεόν κτισθέντα εν δικαιοσύνη
 και οσιότητι (Έφεσ. 4:23-24)*

Προσφιλείς Αδελφοί και Αδελφές εν Χριστώ,

Καθώς πλησιάζουμε την αρχή ενός νέου Ημερολογιακού έτους, είμεθα εξοικειωμένοι με τό κλίμα προσδοκιών και έλπιδος για νέα ξεκινήματα. Μέ την αλλαγή ενός αριθμού και τό γύρισμα μιάς σελίδος τού ήμερολογίου, πολλοί άνθρωποι επιζητούν νά αφήσουν πίσω τους εμπειρίες και προκλήσεις του περασμένου έτους και αδημονούν να υποδεχθούν ένα νέο έτος, νέες εύκαιρίες και καλύτερες συνθήκες ζωής.

Ενώ είμεθα επηρεασμένοι από αυτό το στοιχείο του πολιτισμού μας, γνωρίζουμε ως Ορθόδοξοι Χριστιανοί ότι υπάρχει ένα πολύ σπουδαιότερο κέντρο στο οποίο αρομόζει να εστιάσουμε την προσοχή μας καθώς αναλογιζόμεθα τό παρελθόν και αναμένουμε τό μέλλον. Τό κέντρο αυτό είναι η χάρη του Θεού. Είναι η χάρη Του η οποία μας προσφέρει άφεση αμαρτιών και έλπίδα. Μέσω του ελέους Του ανακαινίζεται η καρδιά, ο νους και το σώμα μας. Διά τής απέραντης αγάπης Του, γεμίζουμε ευγνωμοσύνη για όλα όσα Εκείνος έχει προσφέρει, και προσδοκούμε ένα νέο έτος τεραστίων εύλογιών.

Η προσοχή μας στην ανανέωση της ζωής είναι σημαντική για την καθημερινή μας ζωή. Ταιριάζει, επίσης, και στην ήμερα κατά την οποία τιμούμε τόν Μέγα Βασίλειον. Πρόκειται περί επιβεβαιώσεως της δυνάμεως τής χάριτος. Όταν τιμούμε την ζωή και την μαρτυρία του Αγίου Βασιλείου, αναγνωρίζουμε ότι η χάρη του Θεού «εξεχύθη επ' αυτόν», έτσι ώστε να κατέχη όχι άπλώς την δύναμη νά «αποκαλύπτει τα θεία έργα» αλλά να είναι και «διάκονος τού Ευαγγελίου». Στα έργα, τά κηρύγματα και τις επιστολές του, ο Μέγας Βασίλειος τόνιζε τον ζωτικό

ρόλο της χάριτος του Θεού. Τόνιζε, επίσης, την δύναμη της χάριτος μέσα μιάς ζωής αφιερωμένης στην φροντίδα των αρρώστων, των ορφανών και των υπερηλίκων.

Την ήμερα αυτή και καθ' όλη την διάρκεια του μηνός Ιανουαρίου, αναγνωρίζουμε το ιερό έργο της Ακαδημίας του Αγίου Βασιλείου. Κάθε χρόνο η Εθνική Φιλόπτωχος Αδελφότης και τα τοπικά τμήματά της ηγούνται προσπάθειας συγκεντρώσεως χρημάτων γι' αυτή την διακονία χάριτος. Σάς προσκαλώ να προσφέρετε γενναιόδωρα καθώς συμμετέχετε σ' αυτή την προσπάθεια και στην κοπή τής Βασιλόπιττας. Η φροντίδα, η θεραπεία και η αγάπη που προσφέρονται από το συμβούλιο, τους διευθυντές και το προσωπικό της Ακαδημίας αποτελεί πιστή μαρτυρία της δυνάμεως της χάριτος. Κάθε μέρα, τα παιδιά και οι νέοι της Ακαδημίας βλέπουν και βιώνουν την αγάπη του Θεού ενώ τους προσφέρονται παραδείγματα της αναγκαιότητας της κοινωνίας μαζί Του.

Εκτός απο τα δώρα σας στην Ακαδημία του Αγίου Βασιλείου, σας παρακαλώ να προσεύχεσθε γι' αυτή την διακονία. Καθώς αρχίζει ο νέος χρόνος, ας είσθε έτοιμοι για τις μεγάλες ευλογίες τις οποίες ο Θεός θά χαρίση σε σας και μέσω των ενεργειών σας και σε άλλους. Καθώς εορτάζετε αυτή την ήμερα, έχετε την δυνατότητα να επιβεβαιώσετε ότι η αγάπη και το έλεος του Θεού είναι μαζί σας πάντοτε, και αυτή την ήμερα της ανακαινίσεως, εύχομαι σε σας και τις οικογένειές σας ευτυχισμένο και ευλογημένο το Νέο Έτος.

The Importance of St. Nicholas in My Life

Saint Paul says in his first letter to Timothy: “Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.” (1 Timothy 4:12) The youth of today is the future of tomorrow. The way that we live our life, as the youth, reflects the image of the church tomorrow. As well, we reflect the image of the society and the family tomorrow. More than that, we reflect the nature of the humanity to come.

As a youth, I personally feel that I am responsible to witness for the future of all that I just mentioned. I am a proud Greek. But I have learned that the spirit of Greece is Orthodoxy. When I look at the Greek flag, I see the cross. When I visit my country, I see churches, faith, and tradition. I see the goodness on the people’s faces. And again, I feel responsible for how I will deliver all of that to my children in the future, so that they may feel like me, proud. To witness all these values, as a Greek American, I ask myself, is it enough for me to just learn the Greek language? Or to be active in my church’s festival? Or the church’s fund raising? I’m not saying that is not important, but it is more important to bring a spirit to the body.

The spirit is Orthodoxy, as a way of living, not just as a title. I was an active member in Goya, and now in college, I am the president of the Orthodox group on campus. Today when we are facing all the life challenges, I ask myself more than before, was what I learned in Goya enough to understand what Orthodoxy is? Was it enough for me to be spiritually active? I have the same concerns about my friends, my sisters and brother, and their friends. Are they living their spirituality as Greek Orthodox? Is what we are learning, as the Christian Orthodox youth, enough to face a society that keeps God away from the daily life. Is it enough to face a society where schools do not allow God anymore, but drugs, violence, and hate are all welcomed. All of that brings fear to me, and concerns about the future of my commu-

nity and the future of my children. I am not saying that to criticize anyone.

I love my priest, and I see how hard he works in a big community like ours. I see the hard work of the parish council and the women. I am here to criticize myself in front of all of you by asking, how much have I learned in my church about the history of the church, the sacraments, and the spirituality? How much have I learned about how to live my Orthodoxy and to witness it to others? How much have I understood and enjoyed the liturgical services especially when parts of it are not in English?

How much did I take the Goya events seriously? Whether it was bible bowl, or spiritual retreats. How much have I visited Orthodox monasteries to strengthen my faith? I’m not sure that I did most of that full heartedly. But I wish to all of the youth, to take it seriously because it is important. Let us keep all the good things we have in our beloved church, but let us also add to it what is needed to make it more alive. I ask kindly to all our parents to be more serious about their children’s relationship with the church and God.

I ask with much love to all the youth to take their spiritual life more seriously because the challenges are increasing. I ask the children, to appreciate all that their parents, the priest, and the youth are trying to do for them, to offer them a better life.

Day after day, I see how the days are becoming more evil. And that makes me ask myself if I am being the salt of the earth and the light of the world, as our Lord asked us to be. May the Lord have mercy on me and on all of us, and may he illumine our hearts to see the grace He gave us as true Christians, and may He help us to invest all of His graces for the glory of His name, the glory of His church, and the joy and salvation of our community.
