The 'Greektown Row' housing development, 800 block of Oldham Street, received final approval from the Baltimore City Planning Commission on April 2, 2011 and will now begin demolition of the former Bob's Trucking Depot. The first phase of this development is 141 Ryan townhomes featuring brick facades and two car garages. The Greektown CDC has been monitoring the progress of this development and looks forward to the new homeowners moving to Greektown.



Yianni Sarioglou was born on February 12, 1993 in Baltimore, Maryland and is the son of Panagiotis and Despina. He has an older sister Eleftheria who is a Junior at Stevenson University in the Nursing Program.

Yianni grew up on the soccer field from the early age of five. At his first recreational game at age five he scored five goals playing two age groups up. At age nine he was the leading scorer and scored the golden goal for his team to win the National Indoor Championship.

While playing for the Baltimore Bays Soccer club at age thirteen, Yianni was identified and made the Maryland Olympic Development Program (ODP) and traveled to Scotland with the team to lead his Maryland ODP team as a captain competing against Scottish Premier League giants, Celtic FC. Rangers FC. and Kilmarnock FC. Both in 2007 and 2008 at age 14 and age 15 he helped his Baltimore Bays team to win back to back National Championships as the best team in the country.

In 2009 and 2010 he was selected as a Region 1 pool player out of 100 prospect players in USA ODP Program.

In 2010, he was selected and traveled to Italy with the Maryland team as a captain to compete against Series A side Udinese F.C., A.C. Concordia Sagittaria, Calcio Union Quinto, and A.C. Este 1920.

He is currently attending Calvert Hall College High School where he also played soccer and was named all MIAA his senior year. When he graduates this year, his dream is to attend College and major in Business Administration and continue to play the sport he loves so much. He is currently being scouted by many colleges and has not yet made his decision.

Yianni gives a lot of credit to his parents and his grandparents Yianni and Maria Kevas, the late Kyriakos Sarioglou, and Sofia Sarioglou. He was raised to have strong faith, beliefs, and family values. His dream is to one day play professional soccer but also recognizes the importance of education.
