Κάθε νέο έτος, φέρνει μαζί του την ελπίδα για
νέα ζεκινήματα, που σημαίνει ότι οι άνθρωποι
κάνουν νέες υποσχέσεις και πάιρουν νέες
αποφάσεις. Προσεύχομαι όπως την ανανέωστε
και την ελπίδα του νέου έτους θα τις θυμόμαστε
σε κάθε στιγμή του επομένου έτους, και σε όλα
τα χρόνια που θα ακολουθήσουν. Η κάθε μέρα,
η κάθε στιγμή, να σας φέρνει συνεχώς πιο

να Τον γνωρίσουμε, έτσι ώστε να μπορούμε

ποιος είναι ο Ιησούς Χριστός. Να θυμάστε ότι

"Christ's incarnation is my own recreation"^[1]

Beloved brothers and sisters, dear children in the Lord,

We praise and glorify the God in Trinity, who deemed us worthy once again this year to reach the great feast of the Nativity in the flesh of the Son and Word of God the Father in "little Bethlehem."

The holy Church is celebrating with fullness of joy, for Christ "assumed flesh" through His incarnation^[2] and rendered the Church "an adornment for the world."^[3] Indeed, the entire human race, and even "all of creation," rejoices over this divine blessing. "All of creation is today filled with joy because Christ is born of a Virgin."^[4]

In contrast to the "unmoved mover" of the ancient Greeks, our God is the communion of love and lovingly moves in time toward humankind and the world. "In this is love, not that we loved God but that He loved us." (1 John 4.10)

The pre-eternal Word of the Father, who granted "being" to humankind, now grants us "well being" through His incarnation. "This is the reason behind the feast; this is why we celebrate today: namely, God's descent to us so that we might ascend—or return—to God . . . in order that, by laying aside the old man, we may assume the new man; and in order that, by dying to Adam, we might therefore live in Christ; in order that we might be with Christ, be crucified with Him, be buried with Him, and arise with Him."^[5] The way of deification through grace is henceforth open to everyone coming into the world. All of us are "capable of containing God." "There is neither Jew nor Greek, neither slave nor free man, neither male nor female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus." (Gal. 3.28)

Unfortunately, the Gospel of Christmas is once again proclaimed to a world where the racket of weapons is heard, where unprovoked violence against individuals and peoples is enacted, and where inequality and social justice prevail. It is unbearable to witness the state of countless children, victims of military conflict, irregular situations, manifold exploitations, persecutions and discriminations, as well as hunger, poverty and painful dispossession.

Last April, we had the opportunity in Lesbos to witness with our own eyes—together with His Holiness Pope Francis of Rome and His Beatitude Archbishop Ieronymos of Athens and All Greece—the tragic circumstances of refugees and immigrants, and especially the acute problems of the suffering children, innocents and defenseless victims of military violence, as well as the racial and religious discrimination and injustice, all of which are constantly increasing.

The feast of God's Word, who became an infant—the child Jesus, whose disappearance is pursued by worldly authority, according to the Evangelist Matthew (Matt 2.13)—is a reminder and invitation for us to care for children, to protect these vulnerable victims and to respect the sacredness of childhood.

Of course, children and sensitive souls are also threatened in economically developed and politically stable countries of the world, whether by the immense crisis of marriage and family, or by diverse interventions as well as the use of physical or spiritual force. A child's soul is altered by the influential consumption of electronic media, especially television and the internet, and by the radical transformation of communication. Unbridled economics transfigures them from a young age into consumers, while the pursuit of pleasure rapidly vanishes their innocence.

In light of these dangers, the Holy and Great Council of the Orthodox Church addressed children and young people "with particular love and affection" (Prov. 8) by including the following in its Encyclical:

Amid the medley of mutually contradictory definitions of childhood, our most holy Church presents the words of our Lord: "Unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven" (Matt 18.3) and "whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it (Luke 18.17), as well as what our Savior says about those who "prevent" (Luke 18.16) children from approaching Him and about those who "scandalize" them (Matt 18.6).

The mystery of Christmas is crystallized in the words of the festive Kontakion: "For us, a new child was born, God before all ages." The divine Word as child and the child as God is revealed to the world with "the pure heart" and simplicity of a child. Children comprehend truths, which "wise and prudent" people are unable to approach. As Elytis observes in his poem From one's neighbor: "You can build Jerusalem out of children alone!"

Beloved brothers and sisters in the Lord,

We appeal to all of you to respect the identity and sacredness of childhood. In light of the global refugee crisis that especially affects the rights of children; in light of the plague of child mortality, hunger and child labor, child abuse and psychological violence, as well as the dangers of altering children's souls through their uncontrolled exposure to the influence of contemporary electronic means of communication and their subjection to consumerism, we declare 2017 as the Year of Protection of the Sacredness of Childhood, inviting everyone to recognize and respect the rights and integrity of children.

As underlined in another significant document of the Holy and Great Council, the Church of Christ does not look to "judging and condemning the world" with its word (John 3.17; 12.47), "but rather to offer to the world the guidance of the Gospel of the Kingdom of God, namely, the hope and assurance that evil, no matter its form, does not have the last word in history and must not be allowed to dictate its course."^[6]

Therefore, we venerate our Savior with humility and compunction, for He has visited us from on high; we praise with divine song the immensity of the sacred Incarnation; we kneel down before the All-Holy Theotokos, who holds the child Jesus; and we address from the sleepless Phanar the festive greeting to all children of the Church of Constantinople, both near and afar: "Christ is born; glorify Him. Christ has come from heaven; come out to meet Him," together with our paternal wishes and patriarchal prayer.

"Be strong in the grace of Christ Jesus." (2 Tim. 2.1) Let us all strive together with faith and sincere love in the good struggle of new life in the Church, adhering to all that the Lord has commanded. For He is with us "all the days of our life, to the end of the ages." (Matt 28.20)

Άγαπητοι ἀδελφοί καὶ τέκνα ἐν Κυρίῳ πεφιλημένα,

Ὑμοῦμεν καὶ δοξάζομεν τὸν ἐν Τριάδι Θεόν, τὸν ἀξιώσαντα ἡμᾶς καὶ ἐφέτος νὰ φθάσωμεν εἰς τὴν μεγάλην ἑορτὴν τῆς ἐν “Βηθλεὲμ τῇ μικρᾷ” κατὰ σάρκα Γεννήσεως τοῦ Υἱοῦ καὶ Λόγου τοῦ Θεοῦ Πατρός.

Ἐορτάζει ἐν χαρῷ πεπληρωμένη ἡ Ἁγία Ἑκκλησία, ἡς “σάρκα ἀνέλαβεν” ὁ Χριστὸς σαρκωθεῖς[2], καταστήσας αὐτὴν “κόσμον τοῦ κόσμου”[3]. Σκιρτᾶ διὰ τὰς θείας εὐλογίας ὅχι μόνον σύνολον τὸ ἀνθρώπινον γένος, ἀλλὰ “πᾶσα ἡ κτίσις”. Τὰ σύμπαντα σήμερον χαρᾶς πληροῦνται· Χριστοῦ τεχθέντος ἐκ τῆς Παρθένου”[4].

Ἐν ἀντιθέσει πρὸς τὸ “πρῶτον ἀκίνητον” τῶν Ἀρχαίων, ὁ Θεός ἡμῶν εἶναι καθ' ἔαυτὸν κοινωνία ἀγάπης καὶ κινεῖται ἐν χρόνῳ ἀγαπητικῷ πρὸς τὸν ἀνθρωπὸν καὶ τὸν κόσμον. “Ἐν τούτῳ ἐστίν ἡ ἀγάπη, οὐχ ὅτι ἡμεῖς ἡγαπήσαμεν τὸν Θεόν, ἀλλ' ὅτι αὐτὸς ἡγάπησεν ἡμᾶς”[5].

Ο προαιώνιος Λόγος τοῦ Πατρός, ὃ ὅποιος ἔδωκεν εἰς τὸν ἀνθρωπὸν τὸ “εἶναι”, χαρίζεται εἰς αὐτὸν διὰ τῆς Ἐνανθρωπήσεως Του τὸ “εὖ εἶναι”. “Τοῦτο ἐστὶν ἡμῖν ἡ πανήγυρις, τοῦτο ἑορτάζουμεν σήμερον, ἐπιδημίαν Θεοῦ πρὸς ἀνθρώπους, ἵνα πρὸς Θεόν ἐκδημήσωμεν, ἢ ἐπανέλθωμεν..., ἵνα τὸν παλαίον ἀνθρωπὸν ἀποθέμενοι τὸν νέον ἐνδυσώμεθα, καὶ ὕσπερ ἐν τῷ Ἄδαμ ἀπεθάνομεν οὕτως ἐν τῷ Χριστῷ ἡσωμεν, Χριστῷ καὶ συγγεννώμενοι καὶ συνθαυρούμενοι καὶ συναντάμενοι”[6]. Εἰς πάντα ἀνθρωπὸν ἐρχόμενον εἰς τὸν κόσμον εἴναι πλέον ἀνοικτὴ ὁ δός τῆς κατὰ χάριν Θεώσεως. “Ολοὶ εἰμεθα “Θεοῦ χωρητικοί”. Οὐκ ἔνι Ίουδαῖος οὐδὲ Ἐλλην, οὐκ ἔνι δούλος οὐδὲ ἐλεύθερος, οὐκ ἔνι ἄρσεν καὶ θῆλυν πάντες γάρ ὑμεῖς εἰς ἐστε ἐν Χριστῷ Ιησοῦ”[7].

Δυστυχώς, τὸ Ἐναγγέλιον τῶν Χριστουγέννων κηρύσσεται καὶ πάλιν εἰς ἔνα κόσμον, ὃπου ἡχεῖ ἡ κλαγγὴ τῶν ὅπλων, ὃπου ἀσκεῖται ἀπρόκλητος βία εἰς βάρος ἀτόμων καὶ λαῶν, ὃπου κυριαρχεῖ ἀνισότης καὶ κοινωνικὴ ἀδικία. Αφόρητος εἴναι ἡ κατάστασις εἰς τὴν ὅποιαν εὐρίσκονται τὰ ἀναριθμητα παιδία, θύματα πολεμικῶν συγκρούσεων, ἐκρύθμων καταστάσεων, ποικιλωνύμων ἐκμεταλλεύσεων, διωγμῶν καὶ διακρίσεων, πείνης, πενίας καὶ ἐπωδύνων στερήσεων.

Κατὰ τὸν παρελθόντα Ἀπρίλιον εἶχομεν τὴν εὐκαιρίαν, μετὰ τοῦ Ἅγιατάτου Πάπα Ρώμης Φραγκίσκου καὶ τοῦ Μακαριωτάτου Ἀρχιεπισκόπου Ἀθηνῶν καὶ πάσης Ἑλλάδος Τερανύμου, νὰ διαπιστώσωμεν ἴδιοις ὅμμαστον ἐν Λέσβῳ τὰς περιπετείας τῶν προσφύγων καὶ τῶν μεταναστῶν καὶ ἰδιως τὰ ὄξεα προβλήματα τῶν ταλαιπωρημένων παιδιών, τῶν ἀθώων καὶ ἀνυπερασπίστων θυμάτων τῆς πολεμικῆς βίας, τῶν φυλετικῶν καὶ θρησκευτικῶν διακρίσεων καὶ τῆς ἀδικίας, ὃ ὀριθμὸς τῶν ὅποιων αὐξάνει συνεχῶς.

Ἡ ἑορτὴ τοῦ νηπιάσαντος δι' ἡμᾶς Λόγου τοῦ Θεοῦ, τοῦ παιδίου Χριστοῦ, τὸν ἀφανισμὸν τοῦ ὅποιου ἡτεῖ ἡ κοσμικὴ ἔξουσία συμφώνως πρὸς τὸν Ἐναγγελιστὴν Ματθαῖον[8], εἶναι ὑπόμνησις καὶ κλῆσις νὰ μεριμνήσωμεν διὰ τὰ παιδία, νὰ προστατεύσωμεν τὰ εὐάλωτα αὐτὰ θύματα καὶ νὰ σεβασθῶμεν τὴν ἱερότητα τῆς παιδικῆς ἡλικίας.

Τὰ παιδία καὶ αἱ εὐαίσθητοι ψυχαὶ τῶν ἀπειλοῦνται βεβαίως καὶ εἰς τὰς χώρας τοῦ ἀνεπτυγμένου οἰκονομικῶς καὶ σταθερωτέρου πολιτικῶς κόσμου, ἀπὸ τὴν μεγάλην κρίσιν τοῦ γάμου καὶ τῆς οἰκογενείας, ἀπὸ ποικιλομόρφους παρεμβάσεις καὶ τὴν ἀσκησιν σωματικῆς καὶ ψυχικῆς βίας. Ἀλλοιώνται ἡ παιδικὴ ψυχὴ ἐκ τῆς καταλυτικῆς ἐπιρροῆς τῶν ἡλεκτρονικῶν μέσων καὶ ἰδίως τῆς τηλεοράσεως καὶ τοῦ διαδικτύου εἰς τὴν ὡνήν των καὶ ἀπὸ τὴν ριζικὴν ἀλλαγὴν τοῦ ἐπικοινωνιακοῦ περιβάλλοντος. Ο ἄκρατος οἰκονομισμὸς τὰ μετατρέπει ἐνωρίς εἰς καταναλωτὰς καὶ ὁ εὐδαίμονισμὸς ἐξαφανίζει ταχύτατα τὴν παιδικὴν ἀθωότητα.

Ἐν ὅψει τῶν κινδύνων αὐτῶν ἡ Ἁγία καὶ Μεγάλη Σύνοδος τῆς Ὁρθοδόξου Ἑκκλησίας, ἀπευθυνθεῖσα “μετ' ἴδιαιτέρας ἀγάπης καὶ στοργῆς” πρὸς τὰ παιδία καὶ τοὺς νέους, ἀναφέρει ἐν τῇ Ἐγκυλιῷ αὐτῆς[9] τὰ ἔξης: “Μέσα εἰς τὸν κυκεῶνα τὸν ἀλληλοαναρουσμένων ὄρισμῶν τῆς ταυτότητος τῆς παιδικῆς ἡλικίας, ἡ ἀγιωτάτη ἡμῶν Ἑκκλησία προβάλλει τὰ Κυριακὰ λόγια, ἐὰν μὴ στραφῆτε καὶ γένησθε ὡς τὰ παιδία, οὐ μὴ εἰσέλθητε εἰς τὴν βασιλείαν τῶν Οὐρανῶν”[10] καὶ τὸ “ὅς ἐὰν μὴ δέξῃται τὴν βασιλείαν τοῦ Θεοῦ ὡς παιδίον, οὐ μὴ εἰσέλθῃ εἰς αὐτήν”[11], ὡς καὶ ὅσα ἀναφέρει ὁ Σωτὴρ ἡμῶν δι' ἐκείνους, οἱ ὅποιοι “κωλύονται”[12] τὰ παιδία νὰ τὸν πλησιάσουν καὶ δι' ὅσους τὰ “σκανδαλίζονται”[13].

Τὸ μυστήριον τῶν Χριστουγέννων συμπυκνοῦται εἰς τοὺς λόγους τοῦ Κοντακίου τῆς ἑορτῆς “Δι' ἡμᾶς γάρ ἐγεννήθη παιδίον νέον, ὁ πρὸ αἰώνων Θεός”. Ο Θεός Λόγος ὡς παιδίον καὶ τὸ παιδίον ὡς Θεός ἀποκαλύπτεται εἰς ἀνθρώπους μὲν “καθαρὰν καρδιάν” καὶ μὲ τὴν ἀπλότητα τοῦ παιδίου. Τὰ παιδία κατανοοῦν ἀληθείας, τὰς ὅποιας “οἱ σοφοὶ καὶ οἱ συνετοί” ἀδυνατοῦν νὰ προσεγγίσουν. “Ἄπο παιδίᾳ καὶ μόνον φτιάχνεις Ἱεροσόλυμα”, σημειώνει ὁ Ἐλύτης εἰς τὸ “Ἐκ τοῦ πλησίον”[14].

Ἄδελφοί καὶ τέκνα ἐν Κυρίῳ,

Ἀπευθύνομεν ἐκκλησιν πρὸς πάντας, νὰ σέβωνται τὴν ταυτότητα καὶ τὴν ἱερότητα τῆς παιδικῆς ἡλικίας. Ἐνώπιον τῆς παγκοσμίου προσφυγικῆς κρίσεως, ἡ ὅποια θίγει κατ' ἔχοήν τὰ δικαιώματα τῶν παιδιών, ἐνώπιον τῆς μάστιγος τῆς παιδικῆς θνησιμότητος, τῆς πείνης, τῆς παιδικῆς ἐργασίας, τῶν σωματικῶν κακώσεων καὶ τῆς ψυχολογικῆς βίας, ἀλλὰ καὶ τῶν κινδύνων ἀλλοιώσεως τῆς παιδικῆς ψυχῆς λόγω τῆς ἀνεξέλγυκτου ἐκθέσεως τῶν εἰς τὴν ἐπιρροήν τῶν συγχρόνων ἡλεκτρονικῶν μέσων ἐπικοινωνίας καὶ τῆς καθυποτάξεως αὐτῶν εἰς τὸν καταναλωτισμόν, ἀνακρήσουσμεν τὸ 2017^ο Ετος προστασίας τῆς ἱερότητος τῆς παιδικῆς ἡλικίας, καλοῦντες πάντας νὰ ἀναγνωρίζουν καὶ νὰ σέβωνται τὰ δικαιώματα καὶ τὴν ἀκεραιότητα τῶν παιδιών.

“Οπως τονίζεται εἰς ἔτερον σπουδαῖον κείμενον τῆς Ἁγίας καὶ Μεγάλης Συνόδου, ἡ Ἑκκλησία τοῦ Χριστοῦ, μὲ τὸν λόγον αὐτῆς, δὲν ἀποβλέπει πρωτίστως “εἰς τὸ νὰ κρίνῃ καὶ νὰ καταδικάσῃ τὸν κόσμον”[15], ἀλλὰ εἰς τὸ νὰ προσφέρῃ εἰς αὐτὸν ὡς ὁδηγὸν τὸ Ἐναγγέλιον τῆς βασιλείας τοῦ Θεοῦ, τὴν ἐλπίδα καὶ βεβαιότητα δι τὸ κακόν, ὑπὸ οἰανδῆποτε μορφῆν, δὲν ἔχει τὸν τελευταῖον λόγον εἰς τὴν ἴστοριαν καὶ δὲν πρέπει νὰ ἀφεθῇ νὰ κατευθύνῃ τὴν πορείαν τῆς”[16].

Προσκυνοῦντες ἐν ταπεινώσει καὶ κατανύει τὸν Σωτὴρα ἡμῶν, δοστὶς ἐπεσκέψατο ἡμᾶς ἐξ ὑψους, καὶ ἀνυμνοῦντες ἐνθέοις τῆς περὶ ἡμᾶς θείας Οἰκονομίας, κλίνοντες τὸ γόνον ἐνώπιον τῆς βρεφοκρατούσης Ὑπεραγίας Θεοτόκου, ἀπευθύνομεν ἐκ τοῦ ἀκοιμήτου Φαναρίου τὸν ἔόρτιον χαιρετισμὸν «Χριστὸς γεννᾶται· δοξάσατε. Χριστὸς ἐξ οὐρανῶν· ἀπαντήσατε» πρὸς τὰ μακρὰν καὶ τὰ ἐγγὺς τέκνα τῆς Κωνσταντινουπόλιτος Ἑκκλησίας, καὶ ἀποστέλλομεν πρὸς αὐτὰ τὰς πατρικὰς εὐχὰς καὶ τὴν Πατριαρχικὴν ἡμῶν εὐλογίαν.

“Ἐνδυναμούμενοι ἐν τῇ χάριτι τη̄ ἐν Χριστῷ Ἰησοῦ”[17], ἀς ἀγωνισθῶμεν ἀπαντες ἐν ὁμοψυχίᾳ, ἐν πίστει καὶ ἀγάπῃ ἀνυποκρίτω, τὸν καλὸν ἀγῶνα τῆς καινῆς ἐν Ἑκκλησίᾳ ζωῆς, τηροῦντες ὅσα ἐνετείλατο ἡμῖν ὁ Κύριος, ὁ ὄν μεθ' ἡμῶν «πάσας τὰς ἡμέρας ἔως τῆς συντελείας τοῦ αἰώνος”[18].

My Beloved,

It is time to rejoice, time to share the light of life, time to spread love as the sign of our faith, time to be amazed as we behold the mystery unfolding in the darkness of the cave in Bethlehem. The mystery of our faith is entirely present, embodied by the tiny baby who overnight has become the center of the world, as God enters the doors of humanity. Mankind is amazed as reason encounters its limits. Faith speaks to our intellect and grace calls on our hearts to acknowledge the power of the living God, surrendered into the hands of a newborn. The essence of our Orthodox Christian faith shines with humility and simplicity. Today we welcome the true God and His infinite love for us. We welcome Jesus with the angelic hymn: "Glory to God in the highest, and peace on earth." We welcome the beginning of a new humanity, closer to the divine than ever before.

We are so used to celebrating the earthly birth of our Lord Jesus Christ that we too often forget our sense of wonder at this miracle. Life is a miracle in itself. But when the source of life enters life, it creates an extraordinary new reality in which things remain the same but are entirely different. It is the same experience that Saint John the Theologian had when he wrote in the book of Revelation: "*Now, I saw a new heaven, and a new earth... Then, He who sat on the throne said, 'Behold, I make all things new.'*" (Revelation 21:1-5) Our world seems to have remained the same, old, weary and crushed under the weight of the past. But today we are no longer under the old law, we

have been set free from the past through the body of Christ... Now, as Saint Paul wrote, "*we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter.*" (Romans 7:4-6)

As we celebrate Christ's glorious Nativity, let us reflect on the sense of wonder that we must rediscover. The same wonder that the Theotokos herself experienced when she held her divine child for the first time. The same wonder that the Magi experienced when they saw Jesus. The same wonder that we experience again today as we approach the icon of the feast, and which calls us to live with the joyful memory not of the past, but of the Kingdom to come, singing: "*The Father was well pleased; the Logos became flesh; and the Virgin gave birth to God who became man. A Star reveals Him; Magi bow in worship; Shepherds marvel, and creation rejoices.*" (Sticheron 2)

As Orthodox Christians living in a world which is deeply polarized and divided, it is our mission to offer to our society the genuine meaning of communion as community by seeing others, our neighbors, through the eyes of wonder. It is a similar wonder when parents meet their newborn for the first time, love their child at first glance, even though they still have to get to know him or her. Loving must come before knowing, although today all too often we know more than we love. Love is the free gift that we should offer the world, especially during Christmas time.

May the Joy of Christmas and the Grace and Blessings of our Incarnate Lord be with all of you and your beloved families.

Ἀδελφοί μου ἀγαπητοί,

Πρίν ἀπό δύο χιλιάδες χρόνια καὶ πλέον, οἱ Ἀγγελοι μετέφεραν στήν ἀνθρωπότητα το μήνυμα τῆς Γεννήσεως τοῦ Θεανθρώπου. Τό μήνυμα αὐτό συνετάραξε τότε κόσμο καὶ ἔξακολουθεὶ μέχρι σήμερα καὶ εἰς τόν αἰῶνα νά συνταράζει ἀλλά καὶ νά ἐνθαρρύνει τήν ἀνθρωπότητα, ἐλέγχοντας παραλληλα τήν ἀμαρτία. Ο Κύριος μέ τήν Γέννησή Του, ἐπανέφερε τόν ἀνθρώπο εἰς τήν ἀρχαία δόξα του, ἀπεκατέστησε τό χάσμα μεταξύ Θεοῦ καὶ ἀνθρώπου, τό ὅποι δημιούργησε ἡ παρακοή, καὶ ἀνοιξε καὶ πάλι τίς Πύλες τοῦ Παραδείσου. Ἀν δέν καταδεχόταν ὁ Κύριος, τό δεύτερο Πρόσωπο τῆς Αγίας Τριάδος, νά ἐνσαρκωθεὶ καὶ νά λάβει «δούλου μορφήν», δέν θα ἐπιτυγχάνετο ἡ σωτηρία μας. Γί' αὐτόν τόν λόγο ὁ ιερός Χρυσόστομος καλεῖ τήν ἑορτή αὐτή ως τήν «Μητέρα» ὅλων τῶν ἑορτῶν. Χωρίς τήν Ἐνανθρώπιση τοῦ Λυτρωτοῦ δέν θά ύπηρχε σωτηρία.

Σύμφωνα μέ τήν διδασκαλία τῆς Ἐκκλησίας μας, πλαστήκαμε «κατ' εἰκόνα» καὶ «καθ' ὄμοιώσιν» τῆς Αγίας Τριάδος. Ως ἐκ τούτου ὁ σκοπός τοῦ ἀνθρώπου εἶναι ἡ θέωσή του, ἡ ἔνωσή του δηλαδή μέ τόν Θεό. Ο Υἱός καὶ Λόγος τοῦ Θεοῦ σαρκώνεται γιά νά κάνει δυνατή αὐτή τήν ἔνωση, μιά ἔνωση πού ὅχι μόνο διεκόπη, ἀλλά καὶ ἀποκλείσθηκε μέ τήν ἀνθρώπινη προσφυγή στό κακό. Ο Θεός κατέρχεται στόν κόσμο γιά νά μπορέσει ὁ ἀνθρωπος νά ἀνέλθει στήν θεότητα. «Ο Θεός ἔγινε ἀνθρωπος γιά νά μπορέσει ὁ ἀνθρωπος νά γίνει Θεός!». Αὐτή ἡ πρόταση ἀπαντάται συχνά στούς Πατέρες, καὶ τελικά γίνεται κοινό ἀπόφθεγμα στούς θεολόγους ὅλων τῶν αἰώνων καὶ ἐκφράζει περίτρανα τήν πίστη τῆς Ἐκκλησίας.

Τό Μυστήριο τῆς Θείας Ἐνανθρωπίσεως μεταφράζεται ἀπό τούς ἀγίους Πατέρες μας ως ἡ ύπεροτατη ἐκφραση τῆς ΑΓΑΠΗΣ τοῦ Θεοῦ πρός τόν ἀνθρώπο. Αὐτό σημαίνει πώς ἡ Ἐορτή τῶν Χριστουγέννων εἶναι ἡ ἑορτή τῆς ΑΓΑΠΗΣ. Όχι μιᾶς ἔξωτερης καὶ φαινομενικῆς ἀγάπης πού περιορίζεται σέ ἀνταλλαγή δώρων καὶ σέ ἐκφράσεις προσωρινῆς ἵσως συμπάθειας, ἀλλά μιᾶς ἀγάπης ἀληθινῆς, ἀγάπης ἔως θυσίας, ὅπως

ἀκριβῶς μᾶς ἀγάπησε ὁ Κύριός μας ἔως θανάτου. Καί βεβαίως αὐτή ἡ ἀγάπη πού μᾶς διδάσκουν τά Χριστούγεννα, ἐπεκτείνεται ὅχι μόνο σέ αὐτούς πού μᾶς ἀγαποῦν, ἀλλά καὶ σέ ἐκείνουν πού γνωρίζουμε πώς δέν μᾶς ἀγαποῦν, σέ ὅσους μᾶς ἔβλαψαν, μᾶς πίκραναν, μᾶς κατηγόρησαν... Ἡ σημερινή μεγάλη ἑορτή μᾶς καλεῖ νά ρυθμίσουμε τήν καθημερινότητά μας, σύμφωνα μέ τήν κορυφαία ἀρετή τῆς ΑΓΑΠΗΣ. Βιώνοντας κάθε στιγμή τήν ἀγάπη, ἡ ζωή μας ἔχει νόημα, καταξιώνεται ἀληθινά καὶ μπορεῖ νά ἔχει οὐράνιο στόχο καὶ προορισμό. Διαφορετικά δέν μπορεῖ νά ὑπάρξει ἐλπίδα.



Άνθρωπινα δικαιώματα καταπατοῦνται, τά συμφέροντα τῶν δυνατῶν ύπερισχύουν καὶ οἱ λαοί τῆς γῆς παραμένουν στό σκοτάδι τῆς ἀδικίας, τῆς ἀδιαφορίας, τῆς ἀνισότητας καὶ τοῦ κακοῦ. My Beloved in the Lord, Happy New Year 2017!

As we prepare to enter the year 2017, we should carry with us a spirit of prayer and thanksgiving for the many gifts God has granted us during the course of the past year. Each of us should also ask ourselves the question: during this year have I met the Lord? Have I given Him enough space to change me by His divine grace? Have I recognized the many prints He has left along the path of my life? We have tried, but it was not enough. We could have done more. We should do more, as our world has become a place of insecurity and uncertainty. But how?

Saint Paul wrote that anyone who wishes to work for the Lord will face many difficulties. But as God said to him: *“My grace is sufficient for you, for my strength is made perfect in weakness.”* (2 Corinthians 12:9) So let us look for that grace, and consider what our Church celebrates today as part of the answer. On January 1st, our Orthodox Church commemorates the feast of the circumcision of our Lord Jesus Christ and the feast of Saint Basil the Great. These two celebrations may seem unrelated, but they express the same spiritual truth: there is no spiritual life without sacrifice.

Following the law of the Old Testament, Christ submitted Himself to the Jewish practice of circumcision, offering Himself as a sign of consecration. The Apolitikion of the feast reads: “Fulfilling the Law, of Your own will You accepted circumcision in the flesh, to bring an end to the shadow, and to remove the passions that cover us.” Christ’s

offering only increased during the time of His preaching, until His ultimate sacrifice on the Cross. *"And being found in appearance as man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the Cross."* (Philippians 2:13) Life is given to us, as sacrifice turns it into the sacred mystery of love.

Saint Basil the Great, who lived in the 4th century, embodied this sacred mystery of love throughout his life, shaping our Orthodox Philanthropy by his monastic life and theological knowledge. His charitable program is expressed as a form of prayer in his Divine Liturgy: "Free those who are held captive by unclean spirits; sail with those who sail; travel with those who travel; defend the widows; protect the orphans; liberate the captives; heal the sick... For You, Lord, are the helper of the helpless, the hope of the hopeless, the savior of the afflicted, the haven of the voyager, and the physician of the sick."

If we want this year 2017 to be worthy of God, of our Christian baptism, of the holy name of Orthodoxy, we must as a Church become to all, to each person who may need us, a vision of what mankind can be and what a community of people can hope for under God's love.

May the gift of the New Year 2017 and the Grace and Blessings of our Lord be with all of you and your beloved families.

Ἄδελφοί μου ἀγαπητοί,

Μέ τήν Χάρη τοῦ Τριαδικοῦ Θεοῦ καὶ τίς πρεσβείες τῆς Υπεραγίας Θεοτόκου εἰσερχόμεθα στό νέο ἔτος. Τελοῦμε τήν Θεία Λειτουργία τοῦ ἑορταζομένου σήμερα Αγίου Βασιλείου τοῦ Μεγάλου καὶ παραδειγματιζόμεθα ἀπό τό ἀγία βιοτή του. Ο Μέγας Βασίλειος ἔκανε πράξη τό θέλημα τοῦ Θεοῦ στήν ζωή του καὶ ἔτσι δίδαξε τούς ἀνθρώπους. Γί' αὐτό ὀνομάστηκε «Μέγας» κατά τήν διδαχή του Κυρίου μας: «ὅς δ' ἂν ποιήσῃ καὶ διδάξῃ οὕτος μέγας κληθήσεται ἐν τῇ βασιλείᾳ τῶν οὐρανῶν» (Ματθ. ε' 19). Παράλληλα, τιμοῦμε τήν Μεγάλη Δεσποτική ἑορτή τῆς Περιτομῆς τοῦ Κυρίου, ἡ ὁποία συνετελέσθη κατά τήν ὄγδοη ἡμέρα ἀπό τῆς γεννήσεώς Του, γεγονός πού μᾶς ὑπενθυμίζει μεταξύ ἀλλων τήν ἄκρα συγκατάβαση καὶ ταπείνωση τοῦ Υίου καὶ Λόγου τοῦ Θεοῦ γιά τήν σωτηρία του κόσμου.

Μαζί ὅμως μέ τίς ἑορτές τῆς Ἐκκλησίας μας, σήμερα ἑορτάζουμε καὶ τήν ἀπαρχή τοῦ νέου πολιτικοῦ καὶ κοσμικοῦ ἔτους· τό ὀνομάζουμε κοσμικό ἀφοῦ γιά τούς Όρθοδόξους Χριστιανούς ἡ νέα ἐκκλησιαστική χρονιά ἀρχεται τήν πρώτη Σεπτεμβρίου. Μᾶς δίνεται λοιπόν ἡ εὐκαιρία νά προσδώσουμε σέ αὐτήν τήν κοσμική ἑορτή πνευματικό χαρακτήρα.

Ο λόγος τοῦ Ἀποστόλου Παύλου πού ἀναφέρθηκε ἀνωτέρω θέτει στήν σωστή ὁρθόδοξη πνευματική διάσταση τήν ἀλήθεια περί τοῦ «χρόνου». Ο χρόνος δέν εἶναι δικός μας, ἀλλά τοῦ Θεοῦ. Μᾶς δόθηκε ὡς δῶρο ὥστε νά ἐργαζόμεθα γιά τήν σωτηρία μας. Σύμφωνα μέ τόν Ἀπ. Παῦλο ὁ χρόνος ἀποτελεῖ τόν «καιρό» δηλαδή τήν «εὐκαιρία» καὶ μᾶς συμβουλεύει νά τόν ἀξιοποιοῦμε μέ σύνεση καὶ

φρόνηση «έξαγοραζόμενοι τόν καιρόν, ὅτι αἱ ἡμέραι πονηραὶ εἰσί». Νά μήν αφήνουμε νά περνᾶ ὁ καιρός χωρίς πνευματική ἐργασία διότι οἱ ἡμέρες πού ζούμε εἶναι πονηρές. Αύτό σημαίνει πώς ὁ Διάβολος μᾶς στήνει παγίδες ἀνά πάσα στιγμή μέσκοπό νά μᾶς παραπλανήσει καί νά μᾶς κάνει δικούς του.

Πόσο ἐπίκαιρος ἀκούγεται σήμερα αὐτός ὁ θεόπνευστος λόγος τοῦ Ἀπ. Παύλου! Ζοῦμε πράγματι σέ ήμέρες πονηρές. Στίς μέρες μας τό κακό κυριαρχεῖ. Καθημερινά βλέπουμε ὅτι διαστρέφεται ἡ ἔννοια τοῦ καλοῦ, τοῦ ἡθικοῦ, τοῦ ὡραίου. Χρειάζεται λοιπόν ἴδιαίτερη προσοχή. «Βλέπετε πῶς ἀκριβῶς περιπατεῖτε, μή ώς ἄσοφοι, ἀλλ' ώς σοφοί, ἐξαγοραζόμενοι τὸν καιρόν», λέγει ὁ Ἀπόστολος Παῦλος.

Ἄδελφοί μου ἀγαπητοί,

Μέ τό ἄπειρο ἔλεος τοῦ φιλανθρώπου Θεοῦ ἃς προσευθούμε καί αὐτή τήν νέα χρονιά καί ἃς συνειδητοποιήσουμε ὅτι καθημερινά ἐπιβεβαιώνεται ἡ ἀλήθεια τοῦ Κυρίου, ὅτι «χωρίς ἐμοῦ οὐ δύνασθε ποιεῖν οὐδέν» (Ιω. 15, 5). Ας προσέξουμε λοιπόν! Μήν παρασυρόμαστε ἀπό τό φεῦγα τοῦ κόσμου. Μή σπαταλᾶμε τόν χρόνο μας σέ πράγματα πού φθείρουν τήν ψυχή μας. Μήν ἀφήνουμε τόν ἔαυτό μας ἐκτεθειμένο στήν ἀμαρτία καί σέ ὀτιδήποτε μᾶς παρουσιάζουν οἱ ἄλλοι ὡς «καλό». Άς ἀξιοποιήσουμε τόν χρόνο μας συμμετέχοντας σέ ἔργα ἀγάπης πρός τόν συνάνθρωπο. Άς καλλιεργήσουμε τήν ψυχή μας μέ πνευματική μελέτη καί προσευχή. Άς συμμετέχουμε πιό ἐνεργά, τακτικά καί πρόθυμα στά ίερά Μυστήρια τῆς Ἐκκλησίας μας, στίς ίερές Άκολουθίες καί κυρίως στήν Θεία Λειτουργία τῆς Κυριακῆς. 
G.O.Y.A. SINGS "TA KALANTA" & KEEPS THE GREEK TRADITIONS ALIVE!






