Christ is Risen!


After our spiritual preparation and common journey throughout the blessed and overwhelming period of the Triodion, which began on the Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee, continued with the Great Lent and culminated in the Holy and Great Week, we deserved to worship on Holy Easter, the Glorious Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. It was all so beautiful, so great!

A hymn, which is now sung every Sunday in the church, exhorts us: " Bless God in the churches, the Lord from the fountains of Israel". So, we are invited to worship God in church and not alone, to have the joy and fullness of the community, the spiritual family, the unity among us. The joy of Easter is exactly the joy of celebration, of unity, of meeting friends and loved ones. And it is true that people try to celebrate together by preparing family tables, often traveling long distances, striving to bridge their differences and forgive what separated them and be together again as loved ones, according to the command of the hymn: "Let us forgive everything for the Resurrection". If, therefore, we care so anxiously for the Easter table and meal with our dear friends and family, we ought not much more to be anxious lest we miss the spiritual table, which is the Divine Liturgy of the Resurrection, and where Christ Himself is the Host?


It is more than true that your participation in the worship of the church during this whole period touched me very much, gave me joy and strength. I thank you all sincerely, from the bottom of my heart.

With these spiritual supplies we continue our journey in the season of the Pentecostarion. In this course we meet in May the Sundays of the




However, the same day has a special significance as the "unfortunate day", which was the Fall of Constantinople, on May 29, 1453. The queen of cities, our beloved Constantinople,

Αγαπητοί μου αδελφοί,

Χριστός Ανέστη!

Ύστερα από την πνευματική μας προετοιμασία και κοινή πορεία σε όλη την ευλογημένη και κατανυκτική περίοδο του Τριωδίου, που ξεκίνησε την Κυριακή του Τελώνου και του Φαρισαίου, συνεχίστηκε με τη Μεγάλη Τεσσαρακοστή και κορυφώθηκε την Αγία και Μεγάλη Εβδομάδα, αξιωθήκαμε να προσκυνήσουμε το Άγιο Πάσχα, τη Λαμπροφόρα Ανάσταση του Κυρίου μας. Ήταν όλα τόσο όμορφα, τόσο σπουδαία!

Ένας ύμνος, που ψάλλεται τώρα κάθε Κυριακή στην εκκλησία, όταν γίνεται η Μικρή Είσοδος στη Θεία Λειτουργία, μας προτρέπει: «ἐν ἐκκλησίαις εὐλογεῖτε τὸν Θεόν, Κύριον ἐκ πηγῶν Ισραήλ». Προσκαλούμαστε λοιπόν να λατρεύουμε τον Θεό μέσα στην εκκλησία και όχι ο καθένας μόνος του, για να έχουμε τη χαρά και την πληρότητα της κοινότητας, της πνευματικής οικογένειας, της ενότητας μεταξύ μας. Η χαρά του Πάσχα είναι η χαρά της γιορτής, της ενότητας, της συνάντησης με φίλους και αγαπημένα πρόσωπα. Και είναι αλήθεια ότι προσπαθούν οι άνθρωποι φιλότιμα να γιορτάσουν όλοι μαζί ετοιμάζοντας οικογενειακά τραπέζια, ταξιδεύοντας πολλές φορές μεγάλες αποστάσεις, αγωνιζόμενοι να γεφυρώσουν τις διαφωνίες τους και να συγχωρέσουν όσα τους έχουν απομακρύνει και να είναι πάλι μαζί αγαπημένοι, σύμφωνα άλλωστε και με την προσταγή του ύμνου: «συγχωρήσωμεν πάντα τῆ Άναστάσει». Αν επομένως νοιαζόμαστε με τόση αγωνία για το τραπέζι και το φαγητό του Πάσχα με τους αγαπημένους μας φίλους και την οικογένεια, δεν οφείλουμε πολύ περισσότερο να αγωνιούμε μήπως χάσουμε το πνευματικό τραπέζι, που είναι η Θεία Λειτουργία της Ανάστασης και όπου οικοδεσπότης είναι ο Ίδιος ο Χριστός;

Είναι αλήθεια ότι η συμμετοχή σας στη λατρεία της εκκλησίας σε όλη αυτή την περίοδο με συγκίνησε πολύ, μου έδωσε χαρά και δύναμη. Σας ευχαριστώ όλους ειλικρινά, μέσα από την καρδιά μου.

Η κοινότητά μας, όμως, είχε και άλλες μεγάλες ευλογίες και χαρές τον Απρίλιο. Το Σάββατο του Λαζάρου υποδεχτήκαμε με κάθε τιμή τον ποιμενάρχη μας,

τον Σεβασμιώτατο Αρχιεπίσκοπο Αμερικής, κύριο Ελπιδοφόρο, ο οποίος τέλεσε την Αρχιερατική Θεία Λειτουργία, κήρυξε τον θείο λόγο εκφωνώντας έναν σπουδαίο κατηχητικό λόγο και μας τίμησε στη δεξίωση, που ετοιμάστηκε προς τιμήν του στην όμορφη «Πλατεία» μας. Ήταν πραγματικά μία σπουδαία σελίδα στην ιστορία της εκκλησίας μας, που γιορτάζει φέτος τα εβδομήντα χρόνια από την ίδρυσή της. Μας δόθηκε η ευκαιρία να πάρουμε την ευχή του, να κουβεντιάσουμε, να βγάλουμε φωτογραφίες και να εκφράσουμε τον σεβασμό και την αγάπη μας στο πρόσωπό του.

Με αυτά τα πνευματικά εφόδια συνεχίζουμε την πορεία μας στην περίοδο του Πεντηκοσταρίου. Σε αυτή την πορεία συναντάμε μέσα στον Μάϊο τις Κυριακές του Παραλυτικού, της Σαμαρείτιδος, του Τυφλού και των Αγίων Πατέρων της Πρώτης Οικουμενικής Συνόδου. Συναντάμε επίσης την Απόδοση της γιορτής του Πάσχα, σαράντα μέρες μετά την Ανάσταση, την Τετάρτη 24 Μαΐου αλλά και τη Δεσποτική γιορτή της Αναλήψεως του Σωτήρος, την Πέμπτη 25 Μαΐου. Επίσης, τη Δευτέρα 29 Μαΐου, είναι η καθιερωμένη «Ημέρα Μνήμης», κατά την οποία αναπέμπουμε δεήσεις υπέρ αναπαύσεως των κεκοιμημένων αδελφών μας. Η ίδια ημέρα όμως έχει ιδιαίτερη σημασία για τη Ρωμηοσύνη και ολάκερη την ανθρωπότητα ως η «αποφράς ημέρα», που έγινε η Άλωση της Πόλης, στις 29 Μαΐου 1453. Η Βασιλίδα των πόλεων, η αγαπημένη μας Κωνσταντινούπολη έπεσε στα χέρια των Οθωμανών. Και έμεινε στη μέση η Λειτουργία στην Αγιά - Σοφιά μας, η οποία μάλιστα τα τελευταία χρόνια στα πλαίσια μιας ακραίας προκλητικότητας μετατράπηκε σε τέμενος πλημμυρίζοντας πόνο και αγανάκτηση τις καρδιές μας. Όμως το Πάσχα που γιορτάσαμε πριν λίγες ημέρες μας δίδαξε ότι μετά τον Σταυρό ακολουθεί η Ανάσταση και μετά το πιο βαθύ σκοτάδι ακολουθεί το Άγιο Φως. Έτσι ελπίζουμε, προσευχόμαστε και περιμένουμε μια μέρα να αποκατασταθεί η δικαιοσύνη και να συνεχίσει εκείνη η Λειτουργία που απόμεινε στη μέση πριν πεντακόσια εβδομήντα χρόνια και η Αγιά Σοφιά να λειτουργήσει ελεύθερα ως ναός της αγιασμένης πίστης μας. Είθε.

To the Plenitude of the Church:

May the Grace, Peace and Mercy of Christ Risen in Glory be with you All

* * *

Most honorable brother Hierarchs, Dearly beloved children,

Having arrived with God's grace at the all-saving Resurrection of the Lord, through which the power of death was abolished and the gates of paradise were opened to the entire human race, we address to all of you our paschal greetings and heartfelt wishes, as we proclaim the cry "Christ is Risen" that gives joy to the world.

In all of its dimensions, the life of the Church is invigorated by the ineffable joy of the Resurrection. The "experience of resurrection" is witnessed in the labors of the Saints and Martyrs of our faith, as well as in the liturgical and sacramental life, the proclamation of the Gospel "to the ends of the earth", the devotion and spirituality of the faithful, their sacrificial love and Christian conduct, but also in their expectation of a world where "death will no longer exist, nor will there be mourning, wailing or suffering" (Rev. 21,4).

In and through the Resurrection, everything lies in a state of motion toward perfection in the Kingdom of God. This eschatological drive has always provided Orthodox Christians in the world with dynamism and perspective. Despite the claims of the opposite, as a result of the eschatological orientation of its life, the Church never compromised with the presence of evil in all its expressions in the world. Nor did it deny the reality of pain and death. Nor again did it ignore the ambiguity of human affairs. And finally, it never considered the struggle for a more just world as something foreign to its mission.

Still though, the Church always knew that pain and the cross are not the ultimate reality. The experiential quintessence of the Christian life is the conviction that, through the Cross and through the "narrow gate", we are led to the Resurrection. This faith is reflected in the fact that the core of church life, the Divine Eucharist, is essentially linked with the Resurrection of Christ. In the Orthodox tradition, as the late Metropolitan John of Pergamon emphasizes, the Divine Eucharist "is filled with joy and light … because it is not grounded in the Cross and an idealization of passion, but in the Resurrection as the transcendence of the passion of the Cross". The Holy Eucharist transports us to Golgotha not so that we may remain there, but so that we may be led through the Cross to the ever-radiant glory of the Kingdom of God. The Orthodox faith is the overcoming of the utopian salvation "without the Cross" and of the existential shipwreck of the Cross "without the Resurrection".

Our participation in the Resurrection of Christ through the sacrament of the Church is on the one hand a tangible abolition of every utopianism and of the false paradise promising unimpeded self-indulgence, while at the same time a definitive transcendence of hopeless self-enslavement in supposed unsurpassable negativity, because the Cross of Christ gives birth to the Resurrection, to the "endless delight", to "the enjoyment of eternal glory". The annihilation of death through the Cross and Resurrection of our Savior elevates our life to its divine-human essence and its heavenly destiny.

In Christ, we know and live that the present life is not our entire life, that our biological death does not constitute an end or obliteration of our existence. The biological boundaries of life do not define its truth. After all, the sense that life is an irreversible "journey toward death" leads to existential impasses, to depression and nihilism, to indifference for what truly matters in life. Science, and financial or social progress are unable to offer an essential solution or outlet. Christians are "those who have hope" (1Thess. 4,13), who expect the coming Kingdom of the Father and Son and Holy Spirit as a final reality, as the fullness of life and knowledge, as the fulfilment of joy, not only for the coming generations but for the entire human race from the beginning to the end of the ages.

This vision of history and eternity, the resurrectional nature of Orthodox faith, ethos and culture—namely, the unquestionable fact that the great miracle of Truth is only revealed "to those who venerate the mystery in faith"—is what we are called to witness today within a civilization that rejects the Transcendent and in the context of manifold reductions of the spiritual identity of human existence.

We give glory in chant, hymn and spiritual song to the Lord who rose from the dead and shines eternal life upon all. We participate with joy in "the feast that is common to all". And we beseech the all-powerful, all-wise and all-merciful Maker and Redeemer of all to bring peace to the world and grant all His saving gifts to humankind, so that His all-honorable and majestic name may be glorified and blessed, now and always and to the ages of ages. Amen!

Τιμιώτατοι ἀδελφοί Ἱεράρχαι, Προσφιλέστατα τέκνα,

Φθάσαντες, χάριτι θεία, τήν πανσωστικήν Άνάστασιν τοῦ Κυρίου, δι' ἦς κατηργήθη τό κράτος τοῦ θανάτου καί ἠνεώχθησαν τῷ ἀδαμιαίω γένει αἱ πύλαι τοῦ Παραδείσου, ἀπευθύνομεν πᾶσιν ὑμῖν πασχαλίους προσρήσεις καί ἐγκάρδιον ἑόρτιον χαιρετισμόν, ἀναβοῶντες τό κοσμοχαρμόσυνον «Χριστός Ανέστη!».

Ή ζωή τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, εἰς ὅλας τάς πτυχάς της, δονεῖται ἀπό τήν ἀνεκλάλητον χαράν τῆς Ἀναστάσεως. «Πεῖραν ἀναστάσεως» μαρτυροῦν οἱ ἄθλοι τῶν Ἁγίων καί τῶν Μαρτύρων τῆς πίστεως, ἡ λατρευτική καί μυστηριακή ἐμπειρία, ἡ ἐξαγγελία τοῦ Εὐαγγελίου «ἔως ἐσχάτου τῆς γῆς», ἡ εὐσέβεια καί ἡ πνευματικότης τῶν πιστῶν, ἡ θυσιαστική ἀγάπη καί ἡ κατά Χριστόν ἀναστροφή αὐτῶν, ἡ προσδοκία ἑνός κόσμου, ἔνθα «ὁ θάνατος οὐκ ἔσται ἔτι, οὔτε πένθος οὔτε κραυγή οὔτε πόνος οὐκ ἔσται ἔτι» ¹.

Έν τῆ Ἀναστάσει καί δι' αὐτῆς, τά πάντα εύρίσκονται ἐν κινήσει πρός τήν τελείωσίν των ἐν τῆ Βασιλεία τοῦ Θεοῦ. Αὐτή ἡ ἐσχατολογική ὁρμή ἔδιδε πάντοτε εἰς τήν Ὀρθόδοξον ἐγκόσμιον μαρτυρίαν δυναμισμόν καί προοπτικήν. Παρά τά περί τοῦ ἀντιθέτου θρυλούμενα, λόγω τοῦ ἐσχατολογικοῦ προσανατολισμοῦ τῆς ζωῆς της, ἡ

Έκκλησία ποτέ δέν ἐσυνθηκολόγησεν ἀπέναντι εἰς τήν παρουσίαν τοῦ κακοῦ ἐν τῷ κόσμῳ εἰς ὅλας τάς μορφάς του, δέν ἀπώθησε τήν πραγματικότητα τοῦ πόνου καί τοῦ θανάτου, δέν ἠγνόησε τήν ἀμφισημίαν τῶν ἀνθρωπίνων πραγμάτων, ποτέ δέν ἐθεώρησε τόν ἀγῶνα δι' ἕνα δικαιότερον κόσμον ἀλλότριον πρός τήν ἀποστολήν της.

Έγνωριζεν ὅμως ὅτι ὁ πόνος καί ὁ σταυρός δέν εἶναι ἡ ἐσχάτη πραγματικότης. Η βιωματική πεμπτουσία τῆς χριστιανικῆς ζωῆς εἶναι ἡ βεβαιότης ὅτι διά τοῦ Σταυροῦ, διά τῆς «στενῆς πύλης», ὁδηγούμεθα εἰς τήν Ἀνάστασιν. Ἡ πίστις αὐτή ἀποτυποῦται εἰς τό γεγονός ὅτι ὁ πυρήν τῆς ἐκκλησιαστικῆς ζωῆς, ἡ Θεία Εὐχαριστία, συνδέεται οὐσιωδῶς μέ τήν Ἀνάστασιν τοῦ Χριστοῦ. Εἰς τήν Ὀρθό-δοξον παράδοσιν, ὅπως τονίζει ὁ μακαριστός Μητροπολίτης Περγάμου Ἰωάννης, ἡ Θεία Εὐχαριστία «εἶναι γεμάτη χαρά καί φῶς», διότι «δέν ἔχει ὡς βάση τόν Σταυρόν καί μία ἐξιδανίκευση τοῦ πάθους, ἀλλά τήν Ἀνάσταση ὡς ὑπέρβαση τοῦ πάθους τοῦ Σταυροῦ»². Ἡ Θεία Εὐχαριστία μᾶς μεταφέρει εἰς τόν Γολγοθᾶν ὅχι διά νά παραμείνωμεν ἐκεῖ, ἀλλά διά νά όδηγηθῶμεν, διά μέσου τοῦ Σταυροῦ, εἰς τήν ἀείφωτον δόξαν τῆς Βασιλείας τοῦ Θεοῦ. Ἡ Ὀρθόδοξος πίστις εἶναι ὑπέρβασις τῆς οὐτοπικῆς σωτηρίας «χωρίς Σταυρόν» καί τοῦ ὑπαρκτικοῦ ναυαγίου τοῦ σταυροῦ «χωρίς Ανάστασιν».

Ή μετοχή μας εἰς τήν Ἀνάστασιν τοῦ Χριστοῦ ἐν τῷ μυστηρίῳ τῆς Ἐκκλησίας εἶναι ἀφ᾽ ἑνός ἔμπρακτος κατάργησις κάθε οὐτοπισμοῦ τῶν «εὐρυχώρων ὁδῶν» καί τῶν ψευδεπιγράφων παραδείσων ἀπροσκόπτου εὐδαιμονίας, ἐν ταὐτῷ δέ καί ὁριστική ὑπέρβασις τοῦ ἀπέλπιδος ἐγκλωβισμοῦ εἰς τήν δῆθεν ἀνυπέρβλητον ἀρνητικότητα, ἀφοῦ ὁ Σταυρός τοῦ Χριστοῦ κυοφορεῖ τήν Ἀνάστασιν, τήν «ἄληκτον εὐφροσύνην», τῆς «αἰωνίου δόξης τήν ἀπόλαυσιν». Ἡ συντριβή τοῦ θανάτου διά τοῦ Σταυροῦ καί τῆς Ἀναστάσεως τοῦ Σωτῆρος ἀναφέρει τήν ζωήν μας εἰς τήν θεανθρωπίνην οὐσίαν της καί εἰς τόν οὐράνιον προορισμόν της.

Έν Χοιστῷ γνωρίζομεν καί βιοῦμεν ὅτι ὁ παρών βίος δέν εἶναι ὅλη ἡ ζωή μας, ὅτι ὁ βιολογικός θάνατος δέν ἀποτελεῖ τέλος καί ἐκμηδενισμόν τῆς ὑπάρξεώς μας. Δέν ὁρίζουν τά βιολογικά ὅρια τῆς ζωῆς τήν ἀλήθειάν της. Ἐξ ἄλλου, ἡ αἴσθησις ὅτι ἡ ζωή εἶναι ἀναπότρεπτος «πορεία πρός τόν θάνατον» ὁδηγεῖ εἰς ὑπαρξιακά ἀδιέξοδα, εἰς ἀπόγνωσιν καί μηδενισμόν, εἰς ἀδιαφορίαν διά τά οὐσιώδη τοῦ βίου. Ἡ ἐπιστήμη, ἡ οἰκονομική καί κοινωνική πρόοδος, ἀδυνατοῦν νά προσφέρουν

οὐσιαστικήν λύσιν καί διέξοδον. Οἱ Χριστιανοί εἶναι οἱ «ἔχοντες ἐλπίδα»³, οἱ προσδοκῶντες τήν ἐρχομένην Βασιλείαν τοῦ Πατρός καί τοῦ Υἱοῦ καί τοῦ Ἁγίου Πνεύματος ὡς τήν τελικήν πραγματικότητα, ὡς πληρότητα ζωῆς καί γνώσεως, ὡς χαράν πεπληρωμένην, ὅχι μόνον διά τάς ἐπερχομένας γενεάς, ἀλλά διά σύμπαν τό ἀνθρώπινον γένος ἀπ᾽ ἀρχῆς καί ἄχρι τῆς συντελείας τοῦ αἰῶνος.

Αὐτήν τήν θέασιν τῆς ἱστορίας καί τῆς αἰωνιότητος, τόν ἀναστάσιμον χαρακτῆρα τῆς πίστεως, τοῦ ἤθους καί τοῦ πολιτισμοῦ τῆς Ὀρθοδοξίας, τό ἀδιαμφισβήτητον γεγονός ὅτι τό μέγα θαῦμα τῆς Ἀληθείας ἀποκαλύπτεται μόνον «τοῖς προσκυνοῦσιν ἐν πίστει τό μυστήριον», καλούμεθα νά μαρτυρῶμεν σήμερον εἰς ἕνα πολιτισμόν ἀπωθήσεως τοῦ Ὑπερβατικοῦ καί ποικίλων συρρικνώσεων τῆς πνευματικῆς ταυτότητος τῆς ἀνθρωπίνης ὑπάρξεως.

Δοξάζοντες ἐν ψαλμοῖς καί ὕμνοις καί ῷδαῖς πνευματικαῖς τόν ἀναστάντα ἐκ νεκοῶν καί ἀνατείλαντα πᾶσι τήν αἰώνιον ζωήν Κύριον καί μετέχοντες ἐν ἀγαλλιάσει τῆς «κοινῆς τῶν ὅλων πανηγύρεως», δεόμεθα τοῦ πανσθενοῦς, πανσόφου καί πανοικτίρμονος Ποιητοῦ καί Λυτρωτοῦ τοῦ παντός, ὅπως εἰρηνεύη τόν κόσμον, χαρίζηται δέ τῷ γένει τῶν ἀνθρώπων πάντα τά σωτηριώδη δωρήματα Αὐτοῦ, ἵνα ὑμνῆται καί εὐλογῆται τό πάντιμον καί μεγαλοπρεπές ὄνομά Του, νῦν καί ἀεί καί εἰς πάντας τούς αἰῶνας. Archiepiscopal Encyclical on Great and Holy Pascha

April 16, 2023

Unto the Most Reverend and Right Reverend Hierarchs, Pious Priests and Deacons, the Monks and Nuns, Presidents and Members of Parish Councils, Honorable Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, Members of Leadership 100, the Day and Afternoon Schools, Philoptochos Societies, the Youth, Greek Orthodox Organizations, and the entirety of the Christ-named Plenitude of the Holy Archdiocese of America:

Who will roll away the stone for us? (Mark 16:3)

My beloved sisters and brothers in the Risen Lord,

We have finally arrived at the mystery of mysteries, and we approach the Tomb with the holy Myrrh-bearing Women. With them we ask: "Who will roll away the stone for us?" The guards have scattered, the garden is empty, and we have brought all our potions and ointments to complete His anointing for death. But He is the Anointed One — the Christ — and He has no need of any anointing. He has no need of the stone being rolled away in order to leave death behind. As the young man said to them when they went inside: "He is risen! He is not here!" So, then, why was the stone rolled away?

My beloved Christians, the stone is rolled away in every telling of the story, but not so that the Lord can emerge, but so that we might submerge. The tomb is opened so that we might enter and die to ourselves — to our egos and selfishness. And then we may say, as is chanted in the Paschal Liturgy: "Yesterday I was buried with you, O Christ; and today, I arise by Your Resurrection" (Ode 3). The tomb is our place of transformation. The tomb is the very center of our hearts, where we can fulfill the ancient saying: "If you die before you die, then you won't die when you die."



Therefore, dear brothers and sisters, let us not ask "who will roll away the stone for us?" Let us make the effort to roll it back ourselves! God will send His Angels to help us if we are struggling. But it is within the tomb of dying to ourselves, and dying to this world, that we are reborn in the Resurrection. The stone is heavy, laden with our sins and our heartbreaks, but God forgives all and asks us to do the same. Forgiveness is the power that lifts the stone and paves our way to love. There is a very real resurrection to be had in this life, which leads to life everlasting. The arising in our hearts of love, compassion, and mercy for everyone and everything is the sign that we are truly the children of the Resurrection. May this Pascha reveal to you this mystery of mysteries — this gateway to eternal life, through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ποοσφιλεῖς ἀδελφοὶ καὶ ἀδελφὲς ἐν Κυοίω ἀναστάντι,

Φθάσαμε στὸ μυστήριο τῶν μυστηρίων καὶ πλησιάζουμε μὲ παρρησία στὸ μνημεῖο μαζὶ μὲ τὶς μυροφόρες. Καὶ διερωτώμαστε μαζί τους: «Τίς ἀποκυλίσει ἡμῖν τὸν λίθον»; Οἱ φύλακες ἐξαφανίσθηκαν, ὁ κῆπος εἶναι ἄδειος καὶ ἐμεῖς προσφέρουμε μῦρο καὶ ἀρώματα γιὰ νὰ ἀλείψουμε τὸν πολυτίμητο νεκρό. Ἀλλὰ αὐτὸς εἶναι ὁ Ένας ὁ ἤδη κεχρισμένος, ὁ Χριστός, καὶ δὲν ἔχει τὴν ἀνάγκη τῆς δικῆς μας προσφορᾶς! Δὲν χρειάζεται κἂν νὰ μετακινηθεῖ ὁ λίθος γιὰ νὰ βγεῖ ἀπὸ τὸν τάφο. Όμως ὁ ἄγγελος ἐκείνη τὴν ἡμέρα εἶπε στὶς γυναῖκες ποὺ ἔφθασαν στὸ μνημεῖο: «Οὐκ ἔστιν ὧδε ἀλλὶ ἠγέρθη»! Τότε γιατί μετακινήθηκε ὁ μέγας λίθος;

Άγαπητοί μου χοιστιανοί, στὰ γεγονότα τῆς ἀναστάσεως ὁ λίθος μετακινήθηκε ὅχι γιὰ τὸν ἀναστάντα Κύοιο ἀλλὰ γιὰ ἐμᾶς, γιὰ νὰ μπορέσουμε νὰ συναναστηθοῦμε κι ἐμεῖς μαζί του. Ὁ τάφος ἄνοιξε γιὰ νὰ εἰσέλθουμε σὲ αὐτὸν θάπτοντας τὸν ἄνθρωπο τῆς ἁμαρτίας καὶ τοῦ ἐγωϊσμοῦ. Καὶ ἄς ψάλουμε μαζὶ μὲ τὸν ψαλμωδὸ στὴν πασχαλινὴ



λειτουργία: «Χθὲς συνεθαπτόμην σοι, Χριστέ, συνεγείρομαι σήμερον ἀναστάντι σοι» (Κανόνας τῆς Ἀναστάσεως, ῷδή γ΄). Ὁ τάφος εἶναι τὸ Θαβὼρ τῆς μεταμορφώσεώς μας. Ὁ τάφος εἶναι τὸ κέντρο τῆς καρδιᾶς μας, ὅπου ἐκλπηρώνεται τὸ ρητὸ τῆς νηπτικῆς σοφίας: «Ἀν πεθάνεις πρὶν πεθάνεις, δὲ θὰ πεθάνεις ὅταν πεθάνεις»!

Έτσι, λοιπόν, ἀγαπητοί μου ἀδελφοί, ας μὴ ἀναρωτηθοῦμε «Τίς ἀποκυλίσει ἡμῖν τὸν λίθον». Ἡς κάνουμε κάθε προσπάθεια γιὰ νὰ τὸν μετακινήσουμε μὲ τὶς δυνάμεις μας! Ὁ Θεὸς θὰ μᾶς βοηθήσει στὸν ἀγώνα αὐτόν! Καὶ νὰ εἴμαστε σίγουροι ὅτι στὸν τάφο θάβουμε τὸν κακὸ ἑαυτό μας, θάβουμε τὰ ἐγκόσμια, γιὰ νὰ ἀναγεννηθοῦμε μὲ τὴν ἀνάσταση τοῦ Χριστοῦ! Ὁ λίθος εἶναι ἀσήκωτος ἐξαιτίας τῶν θλίψεων καὶ τῶν άμαρτιῶν μας, ἀλλὰ ὁ Θεὸς μᾶς συγχωρεῖ κατὰ πάντα καὶ μᾶς ζητᾶ νὰ πράξουμε τὸ ἴδιο γιὰ τοὺς συνανθρώπους μας. Ἡ συγχώρηση εἶναι ἡ δύναμη ποὺ μετακινεῖ τὸν λίθο τῆς άμαρτίας καὶ στρώνει τὸ δρόμο τῆς ἀγάπης. Αὐτὴ ἐξάλλου εἶναι καὶ ἡ πραγματικὴ ἀνάσταση στὴ ζωὴ αὐτή, ποὺ όδηγεῖ στὴν αἰώνια ζωή. Ἡς ἀναστηθοῦν στὴν καρδιά μας ἡ ἀγάπη, ἡ συγχώρηση καὶ ἡ φιλανθρωπία γιὰ ὅλους, καὶ ας γίνουμε ἔτσι γνήσια τέκνα τῆς Ἀναστάσεως. Ἡς γίνει αὐτὸ τὸ Πάσχα γιὰ ὅλους μας τὸ μυστήριο τῶν μυστηρίων, ἡ πύλη πρὸς τὴν αἰώνια ζωὴ διὰ μέσω τοῦ ἀναστάντος Κυρίου ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ.

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
HOLY ASCENSION - MAY 25

The Lord Jesus passed forty days on earth after His Resurrection from the dead, appearing continually in various places to His disciples, with whom He also spoke, ate, and drank, thereby further demonstrating His Resurrection. On this Thursday, the fortieth day after Pascha, He appeared again in Jerusalem. After He had first spoken to the disciples about many things, He gave them His last commandment, that is, that they go forth and proclaim His Name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. But He also commanded them that for the present, they were not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait there together until they receive power from on high, when the Holy Spirit would come upon them.

Saying these things, He led them to the Mount of Olives, and raising His hands, He blessed them; and saying again the words of the Father's blessing, He was parted from them and taken up. Immediately a cloud of light, a proof of His majesty, received Him. Sitting thereon as though on a royal chariot, He was taken up into Heaven, and after a short time was concealed from the sight of the disciples, who remained where they were with their eyes fixed on Him. At this point, two Angels in the form of men in white raiment appeared to them and said, "Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into Heaven? This same Jesus, Who is taken up from you into Heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into Heaven" (Acts 1:11). These words, in a complete and concise manner, declare what is taught in the Symbol of Faith concerning the Son and Word of God. Therefore, having so fulfilled all His dispensation for us, our Lord Jesus Christ ascended in glory into Heaven, and sat at the right hand of God the Father. As for His sacred disciples, they returned from the Mount of Olives to Jerusalem, rejoicing because Christ had promised to send them the Holy Spirit.

It should be noted that the Mount of Olives is a Sabbath's day journey from Jerusalem, that is, the distance a Jew was permitted to walk on the day of the Sabbath. Ecumenius writes, "A Sabbath day's journey is one mile in length, as Clement says in his fifth Stromatis; it is two thousand cubits, as the Interpretation of the Acts states." They draw this conclusion from the fact that, while they were in the wilderness, the Israelites of old kept within this distance from the Holy Tabernacle, whither they walked on the Sabbath day to worship God.

RECOGNITION OF TWO NEW SAINTS

On Wednesday, April 26, the Holy and Sacred Synod of the Ecumenical Patriarchate registered Elder Gerasimos Mikragiannanitis and Ecumenical Patriarch Jeremiah I in the list of saints of the Orthodox Church.



Jeremiah I was born in Zitsa in Epirus, and was elected Metropolitan of Sofia around the year 1513. Although he had a limited education, he was well-liked and had a gift for administration. Jeremiah was elected Ecumenical Patriarch by the Holy Synod in 1522.

Two years later while he was traveling, some clergy in Constantinople deposed Jeremiah and uncanonically elected Ioannikios of Sozopol as Ecumenical Patriarch. With the help of the Patriarchs of Antioch and Alexandria, Jeremiah succeeded in overturning the election coup and Ioannikios was deposed by two Synods. Jeremiah was officially restored in 1525, and was enthusiastically received by the clergy and people of Constantinople, gaining great influence from then on.

During his time, the former Cell of Stavronikita was assigned to Patriarch Jeremiah and it was elevated to "Stavronikita Monastery", thus becoming the twentieth monastery of Mount Athos. Following the invitation of the community, Patriarch Jeremiah was personally involved in the reconstruction of the Monastery, of which he emerged as a benefactor and which he declared Stavropegic in 1544.


During his Patriarchate he managed to save many churches, which were threatened with demolition by the Turks. In 1537 Jeremiah obtained a decree by Sultan Suleiman the Magnificent, stopping the conversion of churches in Constantinople into mosques.

In 1538 Jeremiah donated part of his property to the Patriarchate. In 1546 he fell ill, abdicated the Throne, and became a Great Schema monk named John. He fell asleep in the Lord on January 13, 1546.

The annual commemoration our Holy Father Ecumenical Patriarch Jeremiah I is January 13th.

Elder Gerasimos was born in 1905 in Droviani. From a young age, the saint had a zeal for letters. Eventually the saint cultivated the thought of becoming a monk and went to Mount Athos in 1923, becoming a novice in the Hermitage of Saint Anna. In the

desolate, arid, sharp, and barren location, he found absolute spiritual joy and fulfillment of his life's dream. He devoted himself undividedly to the asceticism of the spiritual life and to the study of the sacred ecclesiastical texts. In 1924, the saint received the monastic tonsure, taking the name "Gerasimos".



Elder Gerasimos, among other things, was famous for his hospitality, which he also inspired in others. His ascetic and withdrawn life in no way

affected his sociability. The lay visitors who came to him always left benefited and charmed, as his speech was always careful. Prudent in his responses, he systematically avoided untimely discussions and chatter; he always sought silence, which he considered "the mother of wise concepts". In addition to the laity, the visitors were often clergymen or even monks, who came with the same purpose: to listen to the elder, to benefit spiritually and to learn from his virtuous life.

During his lifetime, he was a librarian and head of the order of services in the kyriakon of the Hermitage of Saint Anna, compiling and publishing a catalog of manuscript codices of the library of the kyriakon of the Skete. In this capacity he helped many scholars in finding and obtaining copies of the manuscripts, and he himself wrote valuable studies and articles.

The saint was once blessed with a vision of Christ "shining, brighter than the sun", along with the imprints of the nails and the wound in His side. The symbols of the Passion were of great significance. It was at this time that the saint was given the gift of hymn-writing, which he previously did not possess, similar to the lives of St. Symeon the New Theologian and St. Romanos the Melodist.

St. Gerasimos Mikragiannanitis was a hymnographer, meaning most of his work was immediately used in the liturgical life of the Church. But he also considered the hymnography itself an extension of prayer, communion with God and the saints: "I have the saint in front of me. That's why I don't want to communicate with anyone. Hymnography, this spiritual work, is a union of the soul with God; it is a wondrous prayer; it is a meditation of the nous; it is a secret theoria; it is a mystery, which is not interpreted and is not externalized with words. Hymnography is the highest philosophy. It does not express itself in words. One has to try it to feel it."

St. Gerasimos fell asleep in the Lord on December 7, 1991. His rich hymnographic work is estimated at more than 2,000 sacred services.

The annual commemoration of the Venerable Gerasimos Mikragiannanitis is December 7th.






