Message from FR. MICHAEL L. PASTRIKOS, PROTOPRESBYTER

uly 4, 1776, commemorates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence. This is a historical day for our Country when the American Revolution began on July 2, 1776, when the Congress voted in favor of Independence. Two days later on July 4th, the delegates of 13 Colonies adopted the Declaration which was drafted by Thomas Jefferson. In honor of the historical day for our country, let us give thanks and debt of gratitude for the courageous men and women who fought all battles for the freedom of our nation. Let us thank them for their fight against our enemies and defending the freedom of Democracy that our nation was founded upon. So today with unified hearts and souls we celebrate the most glorious and special day, in which our

minds and hearts are drawn to this significant event that has been introduced in hope and salvation. In the fight for independence, it was faith in God that engendered courage in the face of injustice, affirmed the priority of human dignity, and emboldened the effort for liberty as an essential quality of human life and potential. This is why today we honor our heroes of the past and our heroes of the present for their courage and love for their country.

In the above segment I gave you a little history of the 4th of July celebration, but to continue let us not forget what our country has gone through within the last two-and one-half years with the corona virus pandemic. It is sad to say that we

did not have much happiness and joy, seeing that we lost over one million Americans from this dreadful virus. Even today we still hear about people suffering from this virus. They are now saying that we will experience another fifth wave from this disease and hundreds of Americans will continue to be infected as we go through the summer and fall months. We as Americans owe a debt of gratitude to our medical doctors, nurses, scientists, and pharmaceutical employees who are continuously on the frontlines battling with resources to produce different ways and means to keep us safe. Let us thank God for the blessings and gifts that He has given us throughout these trying and difficult times.

But today it seems like everyone is in a hurry. We are living in a secularized society where people are pre-occupied with personal and most of all material things. What about the recent shootings in Texas where nineteen children and two teachers lost their lives? I cannot even think what the parents of those children are going through the pain and suffering of losing their children. How many families

and houses have been affected from this tragic and senseless event? I hope and pray that our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ blesses the souls of the little children that lost their lives and bring them into His arms and give them a more peaceful life in heaven above. And I also hope that He brings strength and comfort to the parents who have lost their little angels.

Do we ever hear of anything that is worthwhile? Are we happy with our lives, in the troubled world that we live in? But then I ask this question--Will we ever find peace and love in this world? In our daily life we too find ourselves in a dilemma. Sometimes we are filled with spiritual joys and sometimes with disappointments. Life is like a

seesaw that goes down and then goes up again. We must realize and pray that in everything that we do, our Good Lord always keeps His eyes on us. This is the mystery of the Church. Christ is revealed in that unity between His love and us.

Let us not forget what Christ tells us; that we are the church, we are members of His Body, and together as brothers and sisters in Christ we share the joys and sorrows of each and everyone, to do everything for them just as Christ did for us. When we participate in the life of the Church, the Eucharist, weekly gatherings, and the Divine Liturgy, this is not a personal matter. It is a united journey that we take together on the same road towards our salvation. Today we are messengers of God's Word. We are now His Disciples upon this earth. Μήνυμα Από τον Πατέρα Μιχαήλ Λ. Παστρικό

🔽 τις 4 Ιουλίου 1776, αποφασίστηκε να εορτάζεται η Διακήρυξη Ζτης Ανεξαρτησίας. Είναι ιστορική ημέρα για τη χώρα μας που σημειώνει το ξεκίνημα της Αμερικανικής Επανάστασης, στις 2 Ιουλίου 1776, όταν το Κογκρέσο ψήφισε υπέρ της Ανεξαρτησίας. Δύο ημέρες αργότερα, στις 4 Ιουλίου, οι εκπρόσωποι των 13 Αποικιών ενέκριναν τη Διακήρυξη που συντάχθηκε από τον Thomas Jefferson. Τιμώντας αυτή την ιστορική ημέρα για τη χώρα μας, ας ευχαριστήσουμε και ας ευγνωμονούμε τους γενναίους εκείνους άνδρες και γυναίκες που έδωσαν τη ζωή τους και πολέμησαν για την ελευθερία του έθνους μας. Ας τους ευχαριστήσουμε για τον αγώνα τους ενάντια στους εχθρούς μας και για την υπεράσπιση της ελευθερίας της Δημοκρατίας στην οποία βασίστηκε το έθνος μας. Έτσι, σήμερα με ενωμένες καρδιές και ψυχές γιορτάζουμε την πιο ένδοξη και ξεχωριστή ημέρα, κατά την οποία το μυαλό και η καρδιά μας έλκονται από αυτό το σημαντικό γεγονός το οποίο εισήγαγε την ελπίδα και τη σωτηρία. Στον αγώνα για την ανεξαρτησία, η πίστη στον Θεό ήταν αυτή που γέννησε το θάρρος απέναντι στην αδικία, επιβεβαίωσε την προτεραιότητα της ανθρώπινης αξιοπρέπειας και ενθάρρυνε την προσπάθεια για ελευθερία ως βασική ποιότητα της ανθρώπινης ζωής και των δυνατοτήτων. Αυτός είναι ο λόγος που σήμερα τιμούμε τους ήρωές μας του παρελθόντος και του παρόντος, για το θάρρος και την αγάπη τους για την πατρίδα τους.

Στη παραπάνω παράγραφο σας έδωσα μια σύντομη ιστορική περίληψη του εορτασμού της 4ης Ιουλίου, αλλά για να συνεχίσουμε, ας μην ξεχνάμε τι πέρασε η χώρα μας τα τελευταία δυόμισι χρόνια με την πανδημία του κορωνοϊού. Είναι λυπηρό να λέμε ότι δεν είχαμε ευτυχία και χαρά, βλέποντας ότι χάσαμε πάνω από ένα εκατομμύριο Αμερικανούς από αυτόν τον τρομερό ιό.

Ακόμα και σήμερα εξακολουθούμε να ακούμε για ανθρώπους που υποφέρουν από αυτόν τον ιό. Διαδίδεται τώρα ότι θα βιώσουμε άλλο ένα πέμπτο κύμα αυτής της ασθένειας και εκατοντάδες Αμερικανοί θα συνεχίσουν να μολύνονται κατά τη διάρκεια των καλοκαιρινών και φθινοπωρινών μηνών. Ως Αμερικανοί οφείλουμε ευγνωμοσύνη στους γιατρούς, τις νοσοκόμες, τους επιστήμονες και τους φαρμακοποιούς μας που βρίσκονται συνεχώς στην πρώτη γραμμή για να δημιουργήσουν διαφορετικούς τρόπους και μέσα, ώστε να μας κρατήσουν ασφαλείς. Ας ευχαριστήσουμε τον Θεό για τις ευλογίες και τα δώρα που μας χάρισε σε αυτές τις δοκιμασίες και τους δύσκολους καιρούς.

Σήμερα ως φαίνεται όλοι βιάζονται. Ζούμε σε μια εφήμερη κοινωνία όπου ο κόσμος ασχολείται με προσωπικά και κυρίως με υλικά πράγματα. Παρακολουθεί κανείς τις ειδήσεις ή συνδέεται με τους υπολογιστές μας για να δει τι πραγματικά συμβαίνει ανά τον κόσμο που ζούμε; Δείτε τι συμβαίνει στην Ουκρανία. Χιλιάδες άνθρωποι πεθαίνουν καθημερινά από τους βομβαρδισμούς που κατέστρεψαν τις πόλεις και τα σπίτια όσων ζούσαν εκεί. Εκατομμύρια άνθρωποι έχουν επίσης εκκενωθεί σε διαφορετικές χώρες για να σώσουν τις οικογένειές τους από τον θάνατο και την

καταστροφή. Οι άνθρωποι έχουν ζήσει για μήνες με τρόμο κάτω από γέφυρες, αποθήκες και εργοστάσια χωρίς νερό και τροφή για να συντηρηθούν. Πόσες χιλιάδες στρατιωτικοί έχασαν τη ζωή τους για να υπερασπιστούν την πατρίδα τους; Οικογένειες και τα παιδιά τους έχουν εκτοπιστεί χωρίς να γνωρίζουν την παρούσα κατάστασή τους, πόσο μάλλον το μέλλον τους. Οι πόλεις και τα σπίτια τους καταστράφηκαν και το μέλλον της Ουκρανίας είναι άγνωστο. Αυτό δεν θα έπρεπε να συμβαίνει τον 21ο αιώνα. Τι συμβαίνει με τους πρόσφατους πυροβολισμούς στο Τέξας όπου έχασαν τη ζωή τους δεκαεννιά παιδιά και δύο δάσκαλοι. Δεν μπορώ καν να σκεφτώ τι περνούν οι γονείς αυτών των παιδιών από τον πόνο και την ταλαιπωρία που χάνουν τα παιδιά τους. Πόσες οικογένειες και σπίτια επηρεάστηκαν από αυτό το τραγικό και παράλογο γεγονός; Ελπίζω και προσεύχομαι ο Κύριος και Σωτήρας μας Ιησούς Χριστός να ευλογήσει τις ψυχές των μικρών παιδιών που έχασαν τη ζωή τους και να τα φέρει στην αγκαλιά Του, να τους χαρίσει μια πιο ειρηνική ζωή στον Παράδεισο. Επίσης ελπίζω να χαρίζει δύναμη και παρηγοριά στους γονείς που έχουν χάσει τα αγγελούδια τους.

Ακούμε ποτέ κάτι που αξίζει τον κόπο; Είμαστε ευχαριστημένοι με τη ζωή μας, στον ταραγμένο κόσμο που ζούμε; Αλλά μετά διερωτώμαι -- Θα βρούμε ποτέ ειρήνη και αγάπη σε αυτόν τον κόσμο; Στην καθημερινότητά μας κι εμείς βρισκόμαστε σε δίλημμα. Άλλοτε γεμίζουμε με πνευματικές χαρές και άλλοτε με απογοητεύσεις. Η ζωή είναι σαν μια τραμπάλα που κατεβαίνει και μετά ανεβαίνει ξανά. Πρέπει να συνειδητοποιήσουμε και να προσευχηθούμε ότι σε ό,τι κάνουμε, ο Καλός μας Κύριος έχει πάντα τα μάτια Του στραμμένα πάνω μας. Αυτό είναι το μυστήριο της Εκκλησίας. Ο Χριστός αποκαλύπτεται ανάμεσα στους παρευρισκομένους με την αγάπη Του για μας.

Ας μην ξεχνάμε αυτό που μας λέει ο Χριστός. Ότι είμαστε η εκκλησία, είμαστε μέλη του Σώματός Του, και μαζί ως αδέρφια και αδελφές εν Χριστώ μοιραζόμαστε τις χαρές και τις λύπες του καθενός και της καθεμιάς, πρέπει να κάνουμε τα πάντα για αυτούς, όπως έκανε ο Χριστός για εμάς. Όταν συμμετέχουμε στη ζωή της Εκκλησίας, στη Θεία Κοινωνία, στις εβδομαδιαίες συγκεντρώσεις και στη Θεία Λειτουργία, δεν είναι θέμα προσωπικό. Είναι ένα ενιαίο ταξίδι που κάνουμε όλοι μαζί ακολουθώντας τον ίδιο δρόμο προς τη σωτηρία μας. Σήμερα είμαστε απεσταλμένοι του Λόγου του Θεού. Τώρα είμαστε οι Μαθητές Του πάνω στη γη. Ως Χριστιανοί έχουμε μια αποστολή, και αυτή είναι να διακηρύξουμε την Ορθόδοξη Πίστη μας αγνή και αμόλυντη.

Κλείνοντας, ελπίζω και προσεύχομαι να παραμείνετε όλοι ασφαλείς κατά την εορτή της 4ης Ιουλίου και ο Κύριός μας να συνεχίσει να ευλογεί εσάς και τις οικογένειές σας με υγεία, χαρά και ευτυχία.

Archiepiscopal Encyclical on the National Sisterhood of Presvyteres Sunday

June 5, 2022

Unto the Most Reverend and Right Reverend Hierarchs, Pious Priests and Deacons, the Monks and Nuns, Presidents and Members of Parish Councils, Honorable Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, Members of Leadership 100, the Day and Afternoon Schools, Philoptochos Societies, the Youth, Greek Orthodox Organizations, and the entirety of the Christ-named Plenitude of the Holy Archdiocese of America.

My Beloved Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Οὖτοι πάντες ἦσαν προσκαρτεροῦντες όμοθυμαδὸν τῇ προσευχῇ καὶ τῇ δεήσει σὺν γυναιζὶ καὶ Μαρίᾳ τῇ μητρὶ τοῦ Ἰησοῦ καὶ σὺν τοῖς ἀδελφοῖς αὐτοῦ. (Πράξεις 1:14)

These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers and sisters. (Acts 1:14)

Once again, but for only the second time, we are celebrating National Sisterhood of Presvyteres Sunday. This day – the closest Sunday to June 4th, the Feastday of the Holy Sisters Mary and Martha – has been chosen because it reflects with great distinctiveness the service and ministry of our Presvyteres. Especially in this Centennial Year of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America, the role and contributions of the Presvyteres is rightly praised, for they have been part of the backbone of our Church since its inception. They have taught in Greek and Sunday Schools, led in organizing social services of the communities, and continuously support the clergy of the Church.

The Apostolic quote above illustrates how the women of the Church were significantly involved in the first days of the Church. And on this Sunday of the Holy Fathers of the First Ecumenical Council, which is a bridge between the feasts of Ascension and Pentecost, we should be mindful of our Holy Mothers as well. And this gives us special cause to recognize all the Presvyteres throughout the Sacred Archdiocese of America.

Therefore, let us demonstrate our love and respect for the Presvyteres of our National Church. They make many sacrifices to allow their husbands to serve our parishes, and provide an essential ministry to the Parishes by their example and their leadership. They are most worthy of our honor and gratitude, and of this very special awareness that we bring to their service to Christ and His Holy Church on this National Sisterhood of Presvyteres Sunday.



Introduction

The Feast of the Dormition of Our Most Holy Lady, the Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary is celebrated on August 15 each year. The Feast commemorates the repose (dormition and in the Greek kimisis) or "falling-asleep" of the Mother of Jesus Christ, our Lord. The Feast also commemorates the translation or assumption into heaven of the body of the Theotokos.

Biblical Story

The Holy Scriptures tell us that when our Lord was dying on the Cross, He saw His mother and His disciple John and said to the Virgin Mary, "Woman, behold your son!" and to John, "Behold your mother!" (John 19:25-27). From that hour, the Apostle took care of the Theotokos in his own home.


Along with the biblical reference in Acts 1:14 that confirms that the Virgin Mary was with the Holy Apostles on the day of Pentecost, the tradition of the Church holds that she remained in the home of the Apostle John in Jerusalem, continuing a ministry in word and deed.

At the time of her death, the disciples of our Lord who were preaching throughout the world returned to Jerusalem to see the Theotokos. Except for the Apostle Thomas, all of them including the Apostle Paul were gathered together at her bedside. At the moment of her death, Jesus Christ himself descended and carried her soul into heaven.

Following her repose, the body of the Theotokos was taken in procession and laid in a tomb near the Garden of Gethsemane. When the Apostle Thomas arrived three days after her repose and desired to see her body, the tomb was found to be empty. The bodily assumption of the Theotokos was confirmed by the message of an angel and by her appearance to the Apostles.

Icon of the Feast

The Icon of the Feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos shows her on her deathbed surrounded by the Apostles. Christ is standing in the center (1.) looking at His mother. He is holding a small child clothed in white representing the soul of the Virgin Mary. With His golden garments, the angels above His head, and the mandorla surrounding Him, Christ is depicted in His divine glory.



1. Christ, appearing in His Glory, stands in the center of the icon cradling the soul of His Mother, the Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary.

The posture of the Apostles direct attention toward the Theotokos (2.). On the right Saint Peter censes the body of the Theotokos. On the left Saint Paul (3.) bows low in honor of her.

2. The Apostles bow their heads in reverence to the Theotokos as Saint *Peter* (right) censes her body (detail).

5. The Theotokos lies in the center of the icon surrounded by the **Apostles** and a candle in front of her bed (detail).



Together with the Apostles are several bishops (4.) and women. The bishops traditionally represented are James, the brother of the Lord, Timothy, Heirotheus, and Dionysius the Areopagite. They are shown wearing episcopal vestments. The women are members of the church in Jerusalem.

In front of the bed of the Theotokos is a candle (5.) that helps to form a central axis in the icon. Above the candle is the body of the Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary. Standing over His mother is Christ holding her most pure soul. Above Christ the gates of heaven stand open, ready to receive the Mother of God.

This great Feast of the Church and the icon celebrates a fundamental teaching of our faith—the Resurrection of the body. In the case of the Theotokos, this has been accomplished by the divine will of God. Thus, this Feast is a feast of hope, hope in Resurrection and life eternal. Like those who gathered around the body of the Virgin Mary, we gather around our departed loved ones and commend their souls into the hands of Christ. As we remember those who have reposed in the faith before us and have passed on into the communion of the Saints, we prepare ourselves to one day be received into the new life of the age to come.

We also affirm through this Feast as we journey toward our heavenly abode that the Mother of God intercedes for us. Through Christ she has become the mother of all of the children of God, embracing us with divine love.

Orthodox Christian Celebration of the Feast of the Dormition

The commemoration of the Dormition of the Theotokos and the preparation for the Feast begin on August 1 with a period of fasting. A strict fast is followed on most of the days (no meat, dairy, oil, or wine), with the exceptions of fish on the Feast of the Transfiguration (August 6) and the day of the Dormition. Oil and Wine are allowed on Saturdays and Sundays.

On the weekdays before the Feast, Paraklesis services are held in most parishes. These consist of the Great Paraklesis and the Small Paraklesis, both services of supplication and prayer for the intercessions of the Theotokos.

The Feast of the Dormition is celebrated with the Divine Liturgy of Saint John Chrysostom which is conducted on the morning of the Feast and preceded by a Matins (Orthros) service. A Great Vespers is conducted on the evening before the day of the Feast. Scripture readings for the Feast of the Dormition are the following: At Vespers: Genesis 28:10-17; Ezekiel 43:27-44:4; Proverbs 9:1-11. At the Matins: Luke 1:39-49, 56. At the Divine Liturgy: Philippians 2:5-11; Luke 10:38-42; 11:27-28.


