The Story of St. Ourarios

This is a story about a young Roman soldier, named Ourarios, who was tortured in the name of our Lord, Jesus by the Roman authorities.

The Emperor Maximianus was the ruler of Rome and Ourarios was tortured during his reign in Egypt 304 A.D. Ourarios was a Roman Soldier, but he loved Christianity. He was arrested because he would visit the Christian prisoners in jail to pray with them. For his faith in Christ, he was put to death. He shed his blood for the love of Jesus Christ. During his tortured and execution, there was a woman named Kleopatra who witnessed the death of this young man. She was wealthy widow and had a young son with her at the time of his execution. The executioners badgered Ourarios to change his faith in Christ, but Ourarios rejected them, and as they were torturing him he exclaimed, "I love my Lord my God, and I will never betray you." Kleopatra moved by the faith of this young man requested his body so that she could properly bury him. She gave money to the authorities to persuade them to turn over his body to her. She then proceeded to have his body buried in one of the rooms of her home.

After many years had passed, King Constantine, the Great, became Emperor of the Rome and he stopped all persecutions and executions against all Christians. During the reign of King Constantine Christianity blossomed.

During his reign, Kleopatra left Egypt and returned to her homeland of Palestine. She brought the relics of Ourarios with her and she erected a beautiful chapel in his name burying his relics in the Church. On his Feast Day, Kleopatra invited all the bishops, priests, and faithful of their area for the Consecration of the Church. She provided an abundant meal for all those who attended and she with her son served all those who came to the Consecration. Exhausted from the day's event, not even taking time to eat themselves, they retired for the evening.

During the night, Kleopatra went to her son's room to bring him a plate of food. But, she found him ill burning with a fever. She called for the local doctor as she cared for him that night.

The fever grew stronger and stronger and the boy died in the hands of the mother before the doctor could come. Kleopatra, in the state of shock, cried and cried. She carried her son in her arms to the church and placed his body on the tomb of Ourarios. Crying, she wondered how her son, so young, could die of a fever. She prayed to God and asked Ourarios to intercede for her. With all the crying and stress, she became weary and fell asleep. While sleeping, she had a beautiful dream. She saw the sky open up and a great light. Behind that light stood the martyr of Christ, Ourarios, with a golden wreath on his head. Right next to him, he was holding the hand of his friend, the son of Kleopatras, who was wearing on his head the same golden wreath. At that moment Ourarios spoke to her saying, "Please don't misunderstand me." he said softly. "How many times did you get on your knees to pray for the health of your child? What you see in front of you, can I give you a greater gift than your son wearing the wreath of glory. But, if you really want your son to come back to you alive, then I will free him to you." Ourarios he turned to the son and said, "Look at your mother crying for you to return to her. If you wish you can go back to her."

At that moment the son fell into the arms of Ourarios for he did not want to leave him, and looking at his mother he said, "Do you really want me to give up all this that I have now? I am at peace with myself, and I love it here. I really don't want to come back into this filthy and sinful world that you live in. Do you want me to live eternally with God or do you want me to come back and continue to live a sinful life? Do you want me to change from happiness to sadness? Please mother stop you're crying and mourning and prepare yourself for your journey here. You will truly love it here."

After her dream, she buried her son in the church where Ourarios was buried, and she sold everything that she had and gave it to the poor. She became a very humble and simple person, and she lived the remaining time of her life near the church where her son was buried. Within the span of seven years, Kleopatra died as a Saint.

Μήνυμα απο τον Πατέρα Μιχαήλ

Η ΙΣΤΟΡΙΑ ΤΟΥ ΑΓΙΟΥ ΟΥΑΡΟΥ

Στα ΜΑΡΤΥΡΟΛΟΓΙΑ, που είναι γεμάτα μ'ολόχρυσες σελίδες ηρωϊκών πράξεων, διαβάζουμε την ακόλουθη συγκινητική ιστορία.

Όταν Αυτοκράτορας στη Ρώμη ήταν ο Μαξιμιανός, μαρτύρησε στην Αίγυπτο γύρω στα 304 ο Άγιος Ουάρος, νεαρός ακόμη αξιωματικός της Ρωμαϊκής λεγεώνας. Ζηλωτής χριστιανός, συνελήφθη μέσα στις φυλακές που πήγαινε κρυφά για ν'ανακουφίζει και να δίνει θάρρος στους μάρτυρες. Ήλθε έτσι και η δική του σειρά να χύσει το αίμα του για την αγάπη του Χριστού. Στο τόπο του μαρτυρίου του βρέθηκε, σταλμένη από τη Θεία Πρόνοια, μια πολύ ευσεβής χριστιανή, η Κλεοπάτρα. Ήταν χήρα, αλλά πλουσιωτάτη κι είχε κοντά της το μικρό μοναχογυιό της. Η ευγενής κυρία παρακολούθησε με βαθύ πόνο τα σκληρά βασανιστήρια, που έκαναν στο νέο για ν'αρνηθή την πίστη του. Όταν έμεινε πια άφυχο το μαρτυρικό σώμα, η Κλεοπάτρα έδωσε πολλά χρήματα στους δημίους και το πήρε. Με μεγάλη ευλάβεια το μετέφερε στ'αρχοντικό της και το έθαψε σ'ένα ιδιαίτερο δωμάτιο.

Ύστερα από λίγα χρόνια, όταν βασίλεψε ο Μέγας Κωνσταντίνος και σταμάτησαν οι διωγμοί εναντίον των χριστιανών, η Κλεοπάτρα άφησε την Αίγυπτο για να γυρίσει πίσω στην πατρίδα της, την Παλαιστίνη, και πήρε μαζί της το λείψανο του μάρτυρος, σαν πολύτιμο θησαυρό. Εκεί ξόδεψε ένα μεγάλο μέρος από την περιουσία της κι έκτισε μεγαλοπρεπστάτη εκκλησία στο όνομα του Αγίου Ουάρου κι αφιέρωσε σ'αυτήν το τίμιο λείψανο που φύλαγε μέσα σε ολόχρυση λάρνακα.

Όταν ήσαν πια όλα έτοιμα, προσκάλεσε τον Επίσκοπο και τους κληρικούς της επαρχίας για τα εγκαίνια. Ύστερα από τη Θεία Λειτουργία, φιλοξένησε όλους τους πιστούς και τους έστρωσε πλούσιο τραπέζι. Η χήρα, μαζί με το νεαρό γυιό της, περιποιήθηκαν με τα ίδια τους τα χέρια όλους τους προσκαλεσμένους, χωρίς να βάλουν ψωμί στο στόμα τους. Σαν νύκτωσε και το σπίτι άδειασε από τον κόσμο, τσακισμένος από την κούραση ο νέος, πήγε στο δωμάτιό του να ξεκουραστεί. Σε λίγο πήγε κι η μητέρα να του πάη φαγητό. Τον βρήκε να καιγεται στον πυρετό. Ανήσυχη του έκανε τις περιποιήσεις που ήξερε, ξεχνώντας την πείνα και την κούρασή της. Αλλ'όσο πέραγε η ώρα, ο πυρετός ανέβαινε και προτού προφθάσει να έρθη ο γιατρός, ο νέος ξεψύχησε στην αγκαλιά της απαρηγόρητης μάνας. Αλλόφρονη εκείνη από την απροσδόκητη συμφορά, σήκωσε το νεκρό σώμα και το πήγε στην εκκλησία του μάρτυρος. Το ακούμπησε πάνω στη λάρνακα των λειψάνων και πέφτοντας στα γόνατα, ξέσπασε σε σπαρακτικό θρήνο. Με πονεμένα λόγια θύμιζε στον μάρτυρα, σαν να τον είχα ζωντανό μπροστά της, όσα είχε κάνει για χάρη του και απαιτούσε απ'αυτόν να κάνει εκείνο που έκανε ο Ελισσαίος για τη Σωμανίτιδα.

Ανάμεσα στα δάκρυα και στ'αναφυλλητα, συντριμμένη από τον πόνο, αποκοιμήθηκε. Είδε τότε ένα θαυμάσιο όνειρο, που παρηγόρησε τη μητρική της καρδιά.

Άνοιξε μπροστά της ο Ουρανός και μέσα από φως υπέρολαμπρο παρουσιάστηκε ο μάρτυς του Χριστού,

στεφανωμένος μ'ολόχρυσο στεφάνι. Η δόξα του δεν περιγράφεται. Κρατούσε από το χέρι, σαν φίλος τον φίλο του, το γυιό της χήρας, που φόραγε κι αυτός ολάνθιστο στεφάνι στο όμορφο κεφάλι του.

-Μη με κατηγορείς για αγνωμοσύνη, Κλεοπάτρα, της είπε ο μάρτυς με γλυκύτητα. Θυμάσαι πόσες φορές, γονατιστή μπροστά στα λείψανά μου, γύρευες χάριτες για το παιδί σου; Τι πιο μεγάλο χάρισμα μπορούσα να σου ανταποδώσω από τούτη τη δόξα που βλέπεις; Αν, ύστερα απ'αυτό, εξακολούθεις να τον γυρεύεις κοντά σου, είναι ελεύθερος να έλθη.

Και γυρίζοντας στο νέο, του έδειξε την πονεμένη μητέρα του.

-Φίλε μου, μπορείς να πας μαζί της.

Εκείνος όμως έπεσε στην αγκαλιά του μάρτυρος, σαν να μην ήθελε ποτέ να τον αποχωριστεί, και στρέφοντας στη μητέρα του ελαφρά το κεφάλι, της είπε:

-Επιμένεις λοιπόν να μου στερήσεις αυτή την ευτυχία; Θέλεις ποτέ να με ξαναφέρεις από τα αιώνια στα πρόσκαιρα κ'από τη χαρά στη λύπη; Πάψε μητέρα να πενθείς και ετοιμάσου να μας συναντήσεις.

Βάλσαμο παρηγοριάς χύθηκε στη πληγωμένη καρδιά της χήρας, ύστερα από την οπτασία. Αφού έθαψε το παιδί της στην καινούργια εκκλησία, μοίρασε στους φτωχούς όλη την περιουσία της, φόρεσε ταπεινά ρούχα κι έμεινε εκεί κοντά στον τάφο του μάρτυρος και του παιδιού της. Επτά ολόκληρα χρόνια περιποιήθηκε το ναό και πέθανε με φήμη αγίας.

Η ΓΩΝΙΑ ΤΟΥ ΠΡΟΕΔΡΟΥ

Εν πρώτοις θέλω να ευχαριστήσω όλα τα μέλη της Κοινότητας που παρακολούθησαν τη Γενική Συνέλευση της 30ης, Σεπτεμβρίου, 2013. Η ταμίας του Διοικητικού Συμβουλίου, κ. Πόπη Παραγιού, παρουσίασε το προϋπολογισμό της Κοινότητας για το ερχόμενο έτος 2014, που δείχνει ότι, με τη χάρη του Θεού, η Κοινότητα θα λειτουργήσει με ένα μικρό κέρδος. Επίσης, αναφέρθηκε ότι μέχρι τις 30 Σεπτεμβρίου 2013, είχαν σχεδόν εγγραφεί 100 μαθητές στο Ελληνικό Σχολείο. Συγχαρητήρια δόθηκαν στη κ Σταματία Ιερομονάχου, Πρόεδρο της Σχολικής Επιτροπής, για τις φιλότιμες προσπάθειες της στην εγγραφή των μαθητών.

Επανελλημένα, οι ομιλητές τόνισαν ότι είναι εθελοντές, που εργάζονται για τη βελτίωση της εκκλησίας και την εξάπλωση του λόγου του Κυρίου μας Ιησού Χριστού. 


