## Message from FR. MICHAEL L. PASTRIKOS, PROTOPRESBYTER

### THANKSGIVING DAY

As we approach the end of 2016, we turn our thoughts to the holidays. In November we always look forward to that special day of "Thanksgiving". With the understanding of harvest is also thankfulness to God for all His blessings. Growing up, I think we all have special memories that we carry from one Thanksgiving to another. But sometimes we tend to forget the past. To me, the past is something that we have to respect, because without our past we have no recollection for the present or the future.

There are people today that don't believe that the past is important. They believe that what happens today, in the present is the only thing that is important and valuable. I personally must disagree with this thought. We must accept what happened in the past. Where would we be today if there was no past history to give us some insight and reference? If we don't believe in past events, then we shouldn't believe in Thanksgiving, Christmas, Hanukah, Easter, Science, medicine, Religion, Education, The Arts, Radio, Television, Electricity, Personal Genealogies, Past World Wars, etc. These are events of the past that we continue to honor and celebrate. ### ΗΜΕΡΑ ΤΩΝ ΕΥΧΑΡΙΣΤΙΩΝ

Καθώς πλησιάζουμε στο τέλος του 2016

, οι σκέψεις μας συγκεντρώνονται στις γιορτές. Τον Νοέμβριο περιμένουμε την ξεχωριστή ημέρα των "Ευχαριστιών". Με την συγκομιδή των αγαθών δείχνουμε και την ευγνωμοσύνη μας στο Θεό για όλες τις ευλογίες Του. Μεγαλώνοντας, νομίζω ότι όλοι έχουμε ιδιαίτερες αναμνήσεις χαραγμένες στο μναλό μας από τη μια εορτή των Ευχαριστιών στην άλλη. Άλλα μερικές φορές έχουμε την τάση να ξεχνάμε το παρελθόν. Για μένα, το παρελθόν είναι κάτι που πρέπει να σεβόμαστε, γιατί χωρίς το παρελθόν δεν έχουμε καμία βάση για το παρόν ή το μέλλον.

Οι πρόγονοι μας μας κληροδότησαν την Ημέρα των Ευχαριστιών, τα Χριστούγεννα, το Hanukah, το Πάσχα, μας έδωσαν τις τέχνες, την επιστήμη, την ιατρική, τη θρησκεία, την εκπαίδευση, το ραδιόφωνο, τη τηλεόραση, την ηλεκτρική ενέργεια, τις προσωπικές γενεαλογίες, τους παρελθόντες Παγκόσμιους Πολέμους, κλπ. Αυτά είναι γεγονότα του παρελθόντος τα οποία συνεχίζουμε να τιμούμε και να εορτάζουμε.

Μπορούμε πραγματικά να ξεχνάμε και να βάλουμε στα βάθη της λήθης τα όσα συνέβησαν στον κόσμο; ό, τι και αν κάνουμε σήμερα, πάντα κοιτάμε πίσω στο παρελθόν. Πάνω από 2 χιλιάδες χρόνια, εμείς ως Ορθόδοξοι Χριστιανοί συγκεντρώνουμε τις "Ευχαριστίες" μας γύρω από ένα τραπέζι που καλούμε "Αγία Τράπεζα", είναι η τράπεζα της Ευχαριστίας, και η οποία ουσιαστικά σημαίνει "Ημέρα των Ευχαριστιών". Το μεγάλο γεύμα που μοιραζόμαστε από την Αγία Τράπεζα, είναι το ιερό σώμα και το Αίμα του Κυρίου και Σωτήρος ημών Ιησού Χριστού. Έτσι η Τράπεζα των Ευχαριστιών γίνεται ζωδόχος Τράπεζα.

Εκατομμύρια άνθρωποι θα γιορτάσουν αυτή την ιστορική μεγάλη Εορτή χωρίς να γνωρίζουν το αληθινό νόημα της Ημέρας των Ευχαριστιών. Κατά το παρελθόν, η πρώτοι προσκυνητές υπόφεραν, αλλά μια ημέρα αποφάσισαν να φέρουν ειρήνη στον κόσμο και στις καρδιές τους. Η σημασία αυτής της αξιοσημείωτης ημέρας για εμάς είναι να αποβάλλουμε τα μίση και τις στενοχώριες του κόσμου, να μοιραστούμε μεταξύ μας την αληθινή φιλία και αγάπη. Στην Αμερική γιορτάζουμε αυτήν την ημέρα με την οικογένεια και τους φίλους μας. Η Ημέρα των Ευχαριστιών είναι μια από τις μοναδικές Εορτές που δεν αποβλέπει σε ψώνια και σε αγορές. Το αληθινό της επίκεντρο θα πρέπει να είναι η «Αγία Τράπεζα». Έτσι, όταν μαζευόμαστε γύρω από το τραπέζι με την οικογένεια και τους φίλους μας, πρέπει να είμαστε ευγνώμονες για τα όσα γενναιόδωρα μας χάρισε με τις ευλογίες Του ο Θεός. Αυτή την ημέρα ας σκεφθούμε τους αδελφούς μας που δεν είναι τόσο τυχεροί όσο εμείς. Υπάρχουν άνθρωποι στην Κοινότητά μας που υποφέρουν από μοναξιά, από πείνα. Υπάρχουν παιδιά που πεινούν και δεν έχουν κάποιον να τα

φροντίσει. Τα γηροκομεία είναι γεμάτα με ξεχασμένους ασθενείς, που δεν έχουν συγγενείς ή οικογένεια να μοιραστούν ένα κομμάτι ψωμί την Ημέρα των Ευχαριστιών.

Κάποιος παρατίρησε κάποτε ότι η χειρότερη από όλες τις πιθανές στιγμές για έναν άθεο είναι να αισθάνεται πραγματικά ευγνώμων και να μην έχει κανέναν να ευχαριστήσει. Τα περισσότερα από αυτά τα άτομα δεν είναι πραγματικοί αθεϊστές, αλλά ίσως πρακτικά άθεοι. Ένας πραγματικά άθεος δεν έχει κανένα Θεό να ευχαριστήσει. Ένας πρακτικά άθεος έχει Θεό να ευχαριστήσει, αλλά ποτέ δεν σκέφτηκε να το κάνει. Δεν είναι μήπως αλήθεια ότι στην κοινωνία μας σήμερα, οι περισσότεροι έχουν αφθονία αγαθών, αλλά ξεχνούν ότι όλα αυτά προέρχονται από το Θεό; Άλλα ανταποδώσαμε ποτέ στον Κύριο μας όλες τις καλωσύνες και τις ευλογίες που Εκείνος έχει χαρίσει στον καθένα μας; Την Ημέρα των Ευχαριστιών, πάμε στην Εκκλησία να Τον λατρέψουμε και να Τον ευχαριστήσουμε για ό, τι πραγματικά μας έχει χαρίσει; ή προτιμάμε μάλλον αντί να πάμε στην Εκκλησία να Τον δοξάσουμε να απαλαυσούμε την άνεση του σπιτιού μας και να περάσουμε το υπόλοιπο της ημέρας παρακολουθώντας τα τηλεοπτικά σπορ; Αυτή δεν θα πρέπει να είναι για μας η πραγματική σημασία της Ημέρας των Ευχαριστιών.

Έχουμε την ευκαιρία να τ' αλλάξουμε όλα τουλάχιστον στη δική μας οικογένεια αν συγκεντώσουμε την προσοχή μας στην Τράπεζα του Κυρίου. Ας μετατρέψουμε την εφετεινή "Ημέρα των Ευχαριστιών" σε μια γιορτή για να βοηθήσουμε τους άλλους. Να απλώσουμε το χέρι στους άστεγους, και στις οικογένειες που δεν μπορούν να κερδίσουν τα προς το ζην. Ας ευχαριστήσουμε το Θεό, που ζούμε σε αυτή τη μεγάλη χώρα. Ας αναγνωρίσουμε τις πνευματικές μας υποχρεώσεις προς τους ανήμπτορους. Ακολουθώντας το παράδειγμα του Κυρίου μας, μπορούμε να δείξουμε συμπόνια για όσους πονούν, και υποφέρουν, και να πάρουμε δύξναμη για τις δικές μας στεναχώριες. Με τη βοήθεια Του μπορούμε να δείξουμε τόλμη για ότι είναι καλό, και να ενισχύσουμε την αφωσίσιστή μας σ 'Αυτόν, βοηθώντας τους αδελφούς και τις αδελφές μας που έχουν ανάγκη.

Προσεύχομαι ότι όλοι θα επιλέξουν να εορτάσουν εφέτος την Ημέρα των Ευχαριστιών με εκκλησιασμό και βοηθώντας όσους έχουν ανάγκη. Βρισκόμαστε στο Φθινόπωρο, και το Κοινοτικό μας ημερολόγιο του μηνός Νοεμβρίου είναι γεμάτο με διάφορες εκδηλώσεις- το Food Drive της Φιλοπτώχου, η Γενική Συνέλευση της Κοινότητας, η Χοροεσπερίδα του Παν-Χιακού Συλλόγου και η βραδυά "Ελάτε να Ζωγραφίσουμε", η Συναυλία της Παρέλασης με τον ΔΗΜΗΤΡΗ ΜΠΑΣΗ, Η Συναυλία με THN ΓΛΥΚΕΡΙΑ ΚΑΙ ΤΟΝ ΚΩΣΤΑ ΚΑΡΑΦΩΤΗ προς υποστήριξη ΤΟΥ ΣΠΙΤΙΟΥ ΤΗΣ ΦΙΛΟΞΕΝΙΑΣ, έτσι για να αναφέρουμε μερικές.

Είναι υπέροχο να έχουμε μια ζωντανή και δραστήρια Κοινότητα, αλλά ανησυχούμε σχετικά με τον αριθμό των δραστηριοτήτων και την οικονομική τους επιτυχία σε τόσο σύντομο και κοντικό χρονικό διάστημα. Ενώ ορισμένες από αυτές τις δραστηριότητες πραγματοποιούνται κάθε χρόνο, άλλοι προγραμματίζουν εκ των υστέρων και αφού τα ημερολόγια των οργανισμών έχουν ήδη έγκριθεί από την Επιτροπή Συντονισμού της Κοινότητας. # GUIDELINES FOR RESPECTFUL WORSHIP

Probably the most important duty that we each have as worshippers attending church services is to do all that is in our power to see that a proper decorum and atmosphere is maintained so that all of the congregation is able to pray sincerely, peacefully and meaningfully.

It is with this fact in mind that we have set forth the following guidelines:

Upon entering the Church, at all times, but especially during services an individual should remember that he or she is in the House of God. Reverence and good manners are required so as not to disturb those who are already engaged in prayer, but, even more importantly, as an expression of sincere faith and awareness of the presence of the Lord. No irrelevant conversations should take place, either in the Narthex or in any part of the Church.

According to actual church service procedures, each and every member of the congregation is required to be seated in the pews at the beginning of the service. It is only by leniency that anyone is allowed to enter the Church once the services have begun. Thus it behooves us not to take undue advantage of this leniency.

There are several parts of the service during which no one should be moving about. Wherever a person happens to be at these moments, he or she should stop and stand reverently, until the proper time to proceed. These parts of the service are:



1. The Procession of the Priest and Altar Boys with the Gospel;
2. The reading of the Gospel;
3. The Cherubic Hymn and the Great Procession of the Priest and Altar Boys with the Holy Gifts;
4. The recitation of the Nicene Creed (in which the entire congregation should participate);
5. The prayers of offering “Take, eat...” and the prayers of the consecration of the Holy Gifts;
6. The Sermon;
7. Any special services (memorial services, processions, prayers).

One basic rule to follow is that, whenever the Priest is facing the people or outside of the altar, either with the censer or giving the blessing, everyone should stand wherever they are.

Please remember that the Parish Council members and the ushering staff are required to keep order during services, and all should follow their instructions at all times.






