How do we Prepare for Christmas?

This is the time of the year when everyone starts getting ready for Christmas. The stores are packed with people buying gifts. The houses are decorated with lights and trimmings, and yards become the showcase of Christmas splendor. And yet, we still don't have any idea what Christmas really means. We do not tremble when we think of Christmas, we are not always struck with the wonder of Christ's Birth. Instead, we buy gifts and plan parties, catching a glimpse of the joy of the Feast but without our heart immersed in its wonder.

All these preparations are a wonderful expression of emotions, but how does God want us to prepare ourselves for Christmas? We have gone away from the true essence of why we celebrate the Birth of our Lord. An essential part of preparing for Christmas involves rearranging. Just as we arranged our homes, schedules and other aspects of our daily lives, God would like us to focus on what Christmas is all about. It's not about fun and entertainment. It's not about going to a party or a bar and getting intoxicated. It's not about going to the department stores and buying expensive gifts for your family and friends. Christmas is about Christ.

We see the struggles that people face day to day to preserve the Christmas Spirit. Look at the unemployment rate in this country. People are losing their jobs, their homes, and their livelihood. People are borrowing money that they can't repay. The prisons are filled with inmates that tried to beat the system and failed. Our political system and Government are failing us. They have gotten us into so much debt, that our children and grandchildren will be suffering for years to come to pay the enormous debt that they have put us through. But what can we do as

simple people to correct this problem?

The answer to this question is quite simple. We must make sacrifices and personal decisions that will correct the past mistakes. If we put Christ "First" in our lives then, everything will work out alright and our spirit will surely be filled with love and hope. Once we cleanse ourselves and accept Christ as our true Saviour, then we will see many things that will change in our lives. As Christians, we need to get back to



the basics and the old times when Christ came first in our lives. Today, we have Him on the back burner. Think of Christmas as a Holy Day, where we can make this day a special day in our lives. Let's change the usual way we celebrate Christmas, and reflect on a special recipe that I will prescribe.

If you follow this recipe, it will bring happiness, peace, and love to everyone. There are 4 things to this recipe.

No. 1 - FASTING: During this period of the Nativity Fast (November 15th until Decem-

ber 24th), it is a period of preparation for our souls and bodies. Its benefits are enormous. It is a blessed tool that brings us closer to our self awareness and self evaluation. It opens our eyes to show us who we really are, and where we are heading. It is the key that will open the door to our spiritual destination.

No. 2 - PRAYER: By using this method, prayer is a weapon that relieves all the stress, and pressures of this world. Prayer gives us the inner spiritual strength to battle the problems that we face daily. Prayer is a vessel of communication that links us to God and others. And it also brings peace to our souls and minds.

No. 3 - FORGIVENESS: This is the weapon that beats Satan at his game, and delivers us back to God refreshed and renewed. If we could put a

ΠΩΣ ΠΡΟΕΤΟΙΜΑΖΟΜΑΣΤΕ ΓΙΑ ΤΑ ΧΡΙΣΤΟΥΓΕΝΝΑ;

Τώρα είναι η εποχή που ο καθένας αρχίζει να προετοιμάζεται για τις εορτές των Χριστουγέννων. Τα καταστήματα είναι κατάμεστα από κόσμο που αγοράζουν δώρα. Όλες αυτές οι προετοιμασίες εκφράζουν θαυμάσια τα συναισθήματα, αλλά πως θέλει ο Θεός να προετοιμαζόμαστε για τα Χριστούγεννα; Έχουμε κατά πολύ απομακρυνθεί από την ουσία της εορτής της γέννησης του Κυρίου. Μια ουδιώδης πράξη προετοιμασίας για τα Χριστούγεννα είναι η εκ νέου διευθέτησή της. Ακριβώς όπως κανονίζουμε τα σπίτια μας, και όλα τα άλλα θέματα της καθημερινής μας ζωής. Ο Θεός θάθελε να εστιάσουμε στο θέμα «τι είναι Χριστούγεννα». Δεν είναι διασκέδαση και καλοπέραση. Δεν είναι σαν να πηγαίνουμε σε χορό ή στο μπαρ για να εκτονωθούμε. Δεν είναι σαν να πηγαίνουμε στα

St. Nicholas, The Wonder Worker

St. Nicholas is one of the most revered saints in both the Orthodox and Catholic Churches. We know that his feast was being celebrated as early as the reign of the Emperor Justinian who built a church in his honor at Constantinople just two centuries after St. Nicholas's death. Obviously, he was being venerated before that time and his spiritual legacy must have been well known. Since Justinian's building of the Church consecrated in the saint's name, it has been estimated that thousands of churches, chapels and monasteries have been dedicated to him around the world. His patronage includes children, sailors, fishermen, the falsely accused, merchants, pawnbrokers and many cities and countries.

Surprisingly, although he is one of the most honored and venerated of saints to whom countless miracles have been attributed, very little is historically certain about him except that he was Bishop of Myra in the 4th century. Most of the traditional details about his life emerged during the Middle Ages. St. Methodius of Constantinople, who, in the 9th century, wrote a well-known and influential life of St. Nicholas noted at the time that the majority of the faithful knew nothing of the great saint's life. In fact it is highly probable that St. Methodius himself relied primarily on tradition and legend to produce his account of St. Nicholas.

These traditional details of St. Nicholas' life that have survived and resonated in Christian hearts for well over a thousand years are a powerful testimony to the impression and influence the hierarch must have had on those who were privileged to have had him living and ministering among them. Much can be learned from a brief examination of his life as handed down to us even though we do not possess a perfectly accurate historical account of its facts. The broad outline of St. Nicholas' life, personality and character can be very helpful in instructing and inspiring us in our daily walk with Christ and our struggles to obey and serve Him as He would have us.

St. Nicholas was born in Patara of Lycia to wealthy and influential parents who died when he was a young man. After their deaths he resolved to devote his considerable inheritance to works of charity and was soon attracted to the monastic life. Subsequently, he made a pilgrimage to Egypt and Palestine. Shortly after his return he was elevated to Bishop of Myra and became widely known for his asceticism, piety and acts of

kindness. He was imprisoned and tortured during the persecutions of the Emperors Diocletian and Maximian and released after the accession of St. Constantine. Exactly when or if he had been ordained to the priesthood before his becoming bishop is historically unclear.

What is certain is that St. Nicholas was an ardent defender of the faith against the Arian heresy and it is reputed, though unproven, that he was present at the 1st Ecumenical Council at Nicea in 325. There, he is said to have struck Arius and was expelled by the Council Fathers for his action.


Among the most famous stories about him are his anonymously giving three bags of gold as a dowry to three young women to save them from a possible life of prostitution; the deliverance of three wrongly accused prisoners from execution; the raising from the dead of three murdered children; the miraculous saving of the residents of Myra from famine; the rescue of drowning sailors and the destruction of several pagan temples.

He died at Myra in Lycia on Dec. 6 sometime between 345 and 352. In 1067 Italian merchants stole his relics from Myra and brought them to Bari, Italy where they remain to this day. They have become world renowned for the sweet smelling myrrh with miraculous powers that proceeds from them.

What do these brief glimpses into the great saint's life as it has been handed down to us through the life and tradition of the Church reveal to us about him and how to live a truly Christian life? One luminous truth about St. Nicholas in particular shines through the many centuries to enlighten us. He was a living bearer of the Holy Spirit who humbly and tirelessly embodied and obeyed his Master's two greatest commandments that we should, "love the Lord with all your heart, and with all your soul and with all your mind," and "love your neighbor as yourself." (Mat. 22:37-39)

His life demonstrates a fearless devotion and love for Christ and the truth of the Gospel as well as a constant selfless and compassionate service to those suffering and in need. We would certainly please our Lord if we would emulate him.

Perhaps that is why St. Nicholas is a Wonderworker. The Lord, we may respectfully assume, finds it exceptionally pleasing to grant the intercessory requests of one who loves Him and his fellow human beings so purely and fervently.


